TITLE OF THE PROJECT: HANDS ON CLIL - ERASMUS+ KA2

THE MAIN AIM OF THE PROJECT: Following Europe's challenges and commitment of promoting and intensifying the integrated learning of a foreign language and curricular subject contents, the main objective of this project is to innovate the process of education and enhance cross-curricular foreign language skills of young learners by using CLIL methodology.

 - Partners agreed in changing the pdf docs in eTwinning for Word docs so Turkey can upload them successfully in the website.
- 2. The project coordinators agreed that by the <u>end of April</u> they would send 3 CLIL lessons following the CLIL Tool Kit, with the text checked, and with photos/ resources to illustrate them to the Slovakia's partner (the chosen CLIL lessons are to be sent in Word and pictures in JPG).
 - Slovakia will prepare the Good Practices Catalogue. It was agreed by the partners' coordinators that the Good Practices Catalogue would be ready and sent to all by the <u>end of May</u> for printing. The templates are A4, in colour, and will be printed by each country for future dissemination.
 - For the Catalogue each country is responsible for a CLIL subject:
 - Spain Science
 - Turkey Arts & Crafts + Kindergarten
 - Slovakia PE + Geography + Arts
 - Portugal Introduction + CLIL Tool Kit + Music + Kindergarten
- A10 Each country will do a State of Art Report on CLIL methodology in their countries deadline <u>end of February 2019</u> send all the info to Spain for compilation;
