Due to the pandemic, our school was unable to visit home for disability People.

In November to celebrate Tolerance day, class grade 4th reads the stories that students grade 5th wrote last school year for the project: "We are unique and Beautiful", "Diversity is in the eyes that see it ", "How to be a good friends", "Respect, human equality, empathy". The story talks about different problems: immigration, disability, respect and friendship. Children retell the story using the spoon puppet. They enjoy this activity that helps children to achieve the aims of our project: to increase students' motivation for reading and reflect that respecting people with different opportunities is very important.

Teachers read the book "Wonder Giusy", a story that reflects the life of the author Giusy Versace who has a leg disability due to a road accident. She visited our community and signed our books. Students made some poem about the story "Wodergiusy" that reflect the life of the author.

Class 5th, made some posters about rights that shower in Erasmus corner.

This year on 30 January 2022, a group of people from Emergency NGO "Organization that helps **Refugees and Migrants** had a lesson with class 4th. They read the book "Il mio nome non è **Immigrato"** (My name is not Migrants). A journey through the pages and a journey through the emotions and thoughts of those forced to leave their country; a book that, through direct questions, invites the reader to identify with this difficult, human journey.

The pupils discussed the story and the messages which can be drawn from it to produce a poster. We will have the pleasure to show our work to partners and the community.
