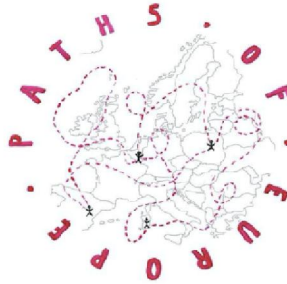

You can find this symbol near to a Baroque Catholic Church. It is located next to the Plaza del Pilar - or Plaza de las Catedrales - and the Fuente de la Hispanidad. It is also very close to the Torreón de la Zuda. It is classified as an Asset of Cultural Interest and a national monument.

TASK 1: You must record a video front of this symbol describing with a couple of words, in the 4 language of your countries, how you the tower looks like.

You can find this nice frog near the sculpture to the Roman emperor with the Empire begins in Rome. It seems that the decision to establish our city came from him, and hence his name: Caesaraugusta.

You can find this statue looking at a missing tower in the Historic District. It is accessed mainly from Alfonso I Street through Torrenueva Street or by the pedestrian street Antonio Candalija. The square stands out for the great beauty of its buildings and for being a quiet and peaceful place to relax while strolling. In the past, the square served as a meeting and sale place for merchants from the adjacent streets who were engaged in handicraft work and used the surroundings of the tower as a market. They emphasize a series of buildings that are: The Church of San Felipe and

Santiago the Minor, the Palace of the Counts of Argillo - Museum of Pablo Gargallo, the Tower of Fortea and the Montal House.

TASK 3: half of yours sit down close to this boy to contemplate the sculpture that half all your group will performance. Take a picture.

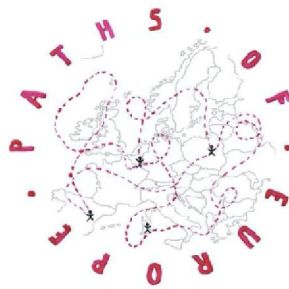

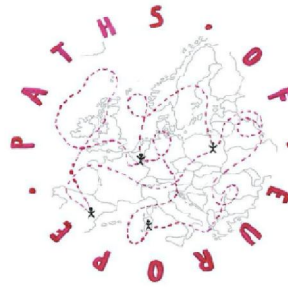
This monument was inaugurated on October 23, 1904. The Monument to the martyrs of religion and homeland is a monument made of stone and bronze.

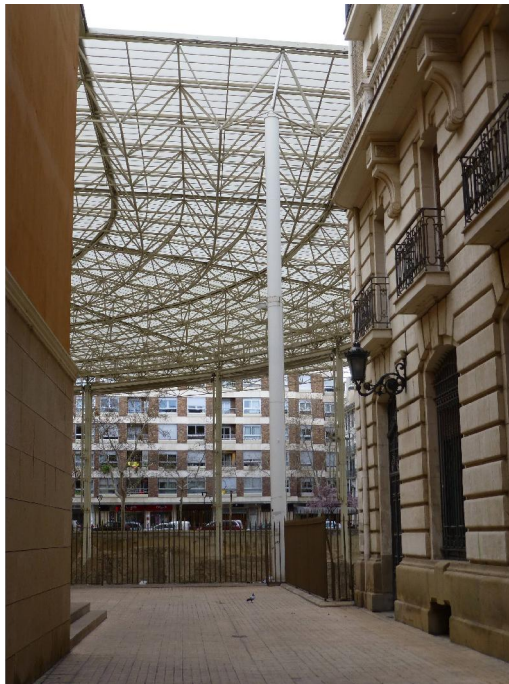
In this small and charming square you can find a chocolate shop where you can reward yourself with a cup of delicious american gold accompanied by the famous churros.

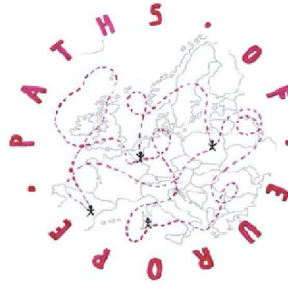

The devil kept his word and in just one night, he built a beautiful and imposing arch. Of course, as might be expected, the devil asked the Dean something in return.

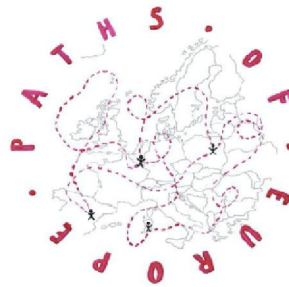
In exchange for the construction of the beautiful arcade, all the people who pass under him, will deliver his soul to the devil when he dies.

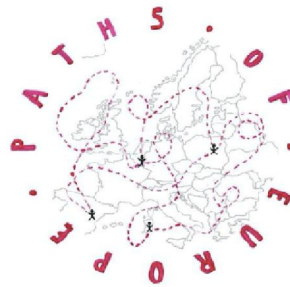

After being put on trial, he was banished to a village in the Pyrenees, where he died. Today is one of the guardians of the door of the city council.

The piece was placed after the remodeling of the Plaza del Pilar and it was inaugurated on May 8, 1991. It is included within the square dedicated to the Discovery of America.

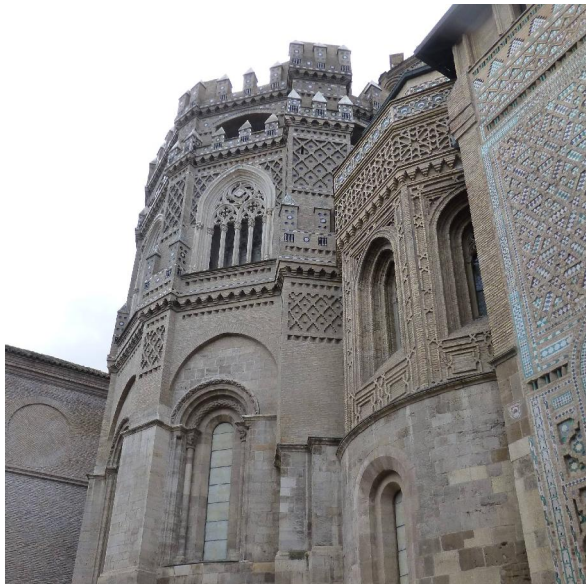
TASKS 11: Take a picture of your group in a big hug to our mother earth.

La Seo de San Salvador is one of the most important monuments of Aragon for being an example of the fusion of artistic styles and the first Christian cathedral of Zaragoza. It is important not only in the quality of its architectural and decorative elements, made by the best medieval,



Renaissance and Baroque artists, but also because it reflects the history and art of Aragon since the Middle Ages. It has been the seat of the most relevant ceremonies related to the Crown of Aragon.

La Seo de Zaragoza was included in the declaration of World Heritage that UNESCO granted in 2001 to

the Aragonese Mudejar.

TASKS 12: After admiring this unique and magnificent monument, look for a Camino de Santiago shell just front of this corner. Record a video of all the members of your group dancing around it.
