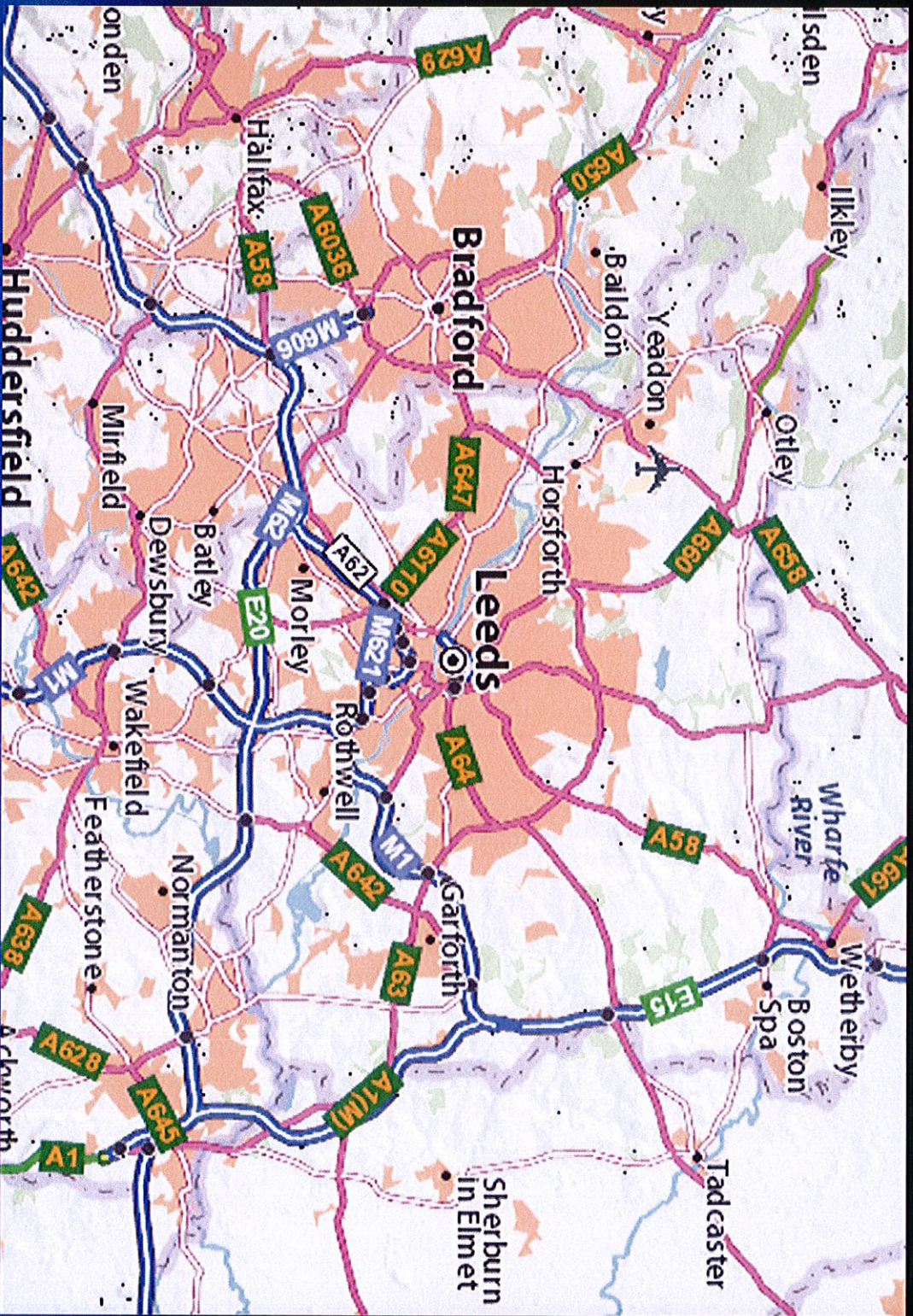


THE MAP OF YORKSHIRE



FACTS OF YORKSHIRE

- Yorkshire was split into three Ridings – East Riding, North Riding and West Riding: this area includes modern counties, such as Humberside, Durham, Cumbria, Cleveland and even parts of Lancashire.
- Yorkshire Day is held on 1 August every year to celebrate Yorkshire's unique culture and dialect.
- After the death of Richard II, there was a civil war between the House of Lancaster and the House of York over the next successor to the English crown.
- Yorkshire has sometimes been nicknamed God's Own County.
- The unofficial anthem of Yorkshire is the popular folk song *On Ilkka Moor Baht 'at* ("On Ilkley Moor without a hat").
