Topic of the lesson: Children volunteering

Objectives of the lesson:

Process of the lesson: teaching and learning activities

The activities during the lesson were organized using methods such as dialogue, heuristic conversation, writing an essay, group collaboration

At the beginning of the lesson students were presented with the video of little Andreas. Following the video, there was a group talk.

Thereafter, the students were separated into groups and were asked to come up with ten words (verbs, subjects, adjectives) which would define little Andrea's contribution. Each group wrote their list of words on the board.

Each group discussed the moral values of which a child should have in order to become an active volunteer. In addition, they presented in class an argument in favor of having moral values.

At the end of the class, each student wrote an essay 120-160 words about how children's volunteering can help resolve the problems of their age group (having used all their learning and resources in class).
