## Lesson Plan 1

Subject: Composition

Teacher: Fani Gountra

Topic of the lesson: the value of self-sacrifice

Objectives of the lesson: to familiarize students with the meaning of sacrifice, to empathize with the motives of a heroic act and to practice their writing skills.

List of required material: photocopies, whiteboard, notebooks
