## Lesson Plan 3

Form: 7<sup>th</sup>

Subject: Literature

Teacher: Sophia Papadopoulou

Topic of the lesson: Literature and Art

Objectives of the lesson: emotional goals (to get students to empathize with self-sacrificial acts and to take part in activities related to different art forms which are inspired by Telemaxos' story, psychomotor goals

List of required material: video, video projector, computer, paper

Process of the lesson: teaching and learning activities. During the lesson the students watched a video about the story of Telemaxos created by the students involved in "We are the world, we are the children". The teacher, before the end of the video, asked for alternative endings to the story. After the completion of the video presentation, the students compared their story endings amongst themselves. In this way, they were able to understand the heroic act of Telemaxos. Later, they separated into groups and were asked to create an art form with Telemaxos' story. The first group came up with a musical composition to go along with the video. The second group drew a painting which went along with the story.
