### Lesson Plan

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Activity:

1. Think that you are the heroine (Ero Konstantopoulou). You want to convince the army officer who has arrested you about the unfairness his country shows towards yours.
  - a. Try to convince him using pantomime (3')
  - b. Use only three words which you think that are highly important and effective to convince.
  - c. Convince him using a song or a poem which you will select.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Activity:

Draw something which you think that passes a peaceful message (in relation to our story).

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Activity:

If Ero wasn't killed, would she live a peaceful and harmonious life or not?

Would all these incidents affect the rest of her life? If yes, how? (negatively? / positively?)

What advice would she give to a young person nowadays?

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Activity:

Are there any young people nowadays who can devote themselves for values and ideals like Ero did? If no, why? If yes, which are they?
