Plan:

Short term:

Promote an **International breakfast** the last day of this school year where parents from different countries bring some traditional dishes to share with the school community.

Long term:

Create an **International corner** with different materials (books, games, etc) from different countries including a big world map to locate the origin countries of our students.

DO:
