# **Goals:**

#### Didactical approach & organisation

The didactical approach is the cooperative learning and the knowledge of the textual language for a meaningful learning.

**1**<sup>st</sup> **step:** Children send foreign students the name of five typical dishes, written in the their own language(Portuguese and Italian language);

**2**<sup>nd</sup> **step:** Students choose one of the dishes and look for information about it: history; ingredients; how to cook it...

3<sup>rd</sup> step: The students show the foreign students what they learned about the dish;

**4**<sup>th</sup> **step:** The students have to write the correct procedure to prepare the dish;

5<sup>th</sup> step: Cooking show;

6<sup>th</sup> step: PPT presentation containing the main elements of the project.
