Short term:

- Include parents in a structural way with the activities.

Long term:

- Involve more schools in our Region to informe them about the internationalization experience done.

Do:

Short term:

- Parents and teachers plan and organanize an International Day at school.
- Setting up an internationalisation group of teachers in our school to involve all teacher in CLIL activities.

Long term:

- Headmasters and teachers from different schools involved in Erasmus+ Projects, plan and organize International meetings in each school once a year, disseminate the experiences with cultural and educational associations.
