#### Plitvice Lakes

- the first national park in Croatiaconsists of 16 lakes
- on the UNESCO Cultural Heritage List







#### Arena in Pula

- one of the largest preserved Roman amphitheaters in the world
- the traditional Pula Film Festival is held there
- built between 27 BC and 68 AD





#### Island Brac

famous Zlatni rat beach – changes shape depending on the wind and waves
production of high quality stone







#### Zadar

- the Church of Saint Donatus (9th century) the largest Pre-Romanesque building in Croatia
- Sea Organ a sound art object that creates tunes using the rolling power of sea waves



#### Motovun

- a stone town perched on top of a hill
- famous film festival is held there






#### Dubrovník

- many different plants and animals live there



























- the smallest town in the world






- seven waterfalls
