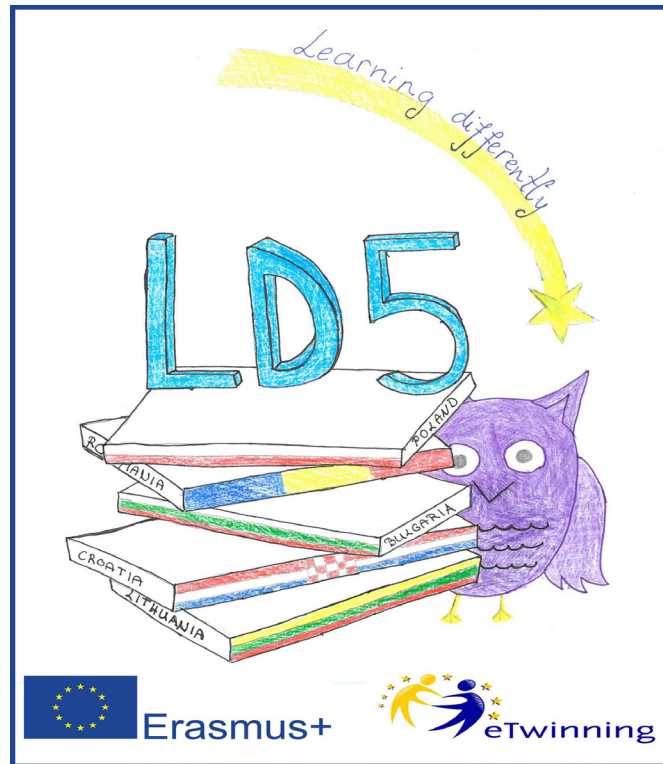




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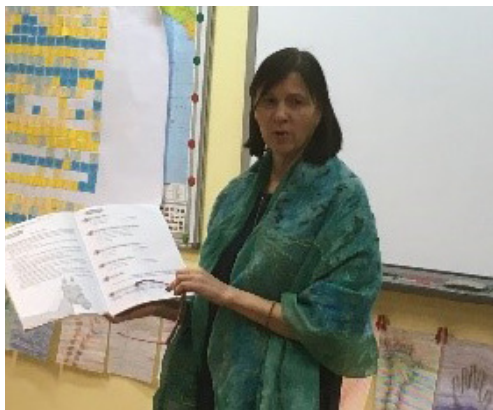

**• What kind of mobility activities were useful for you?**

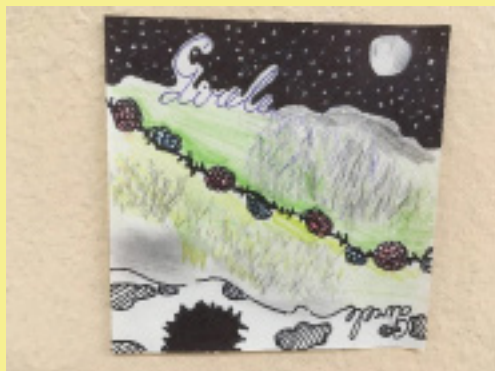
Project teachers have shared their experiences about used methods in their countries.

**• What do you wish for our partners?**

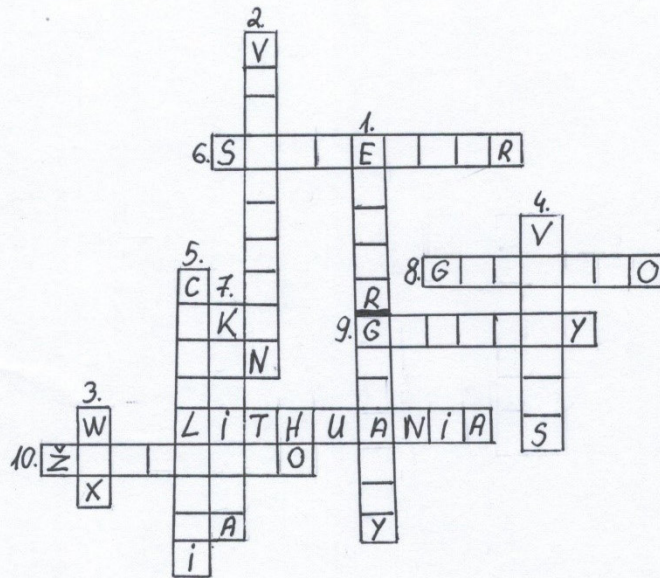
Stay friendly, creative, nice people – colleagues. Also to improve competency in their fields.

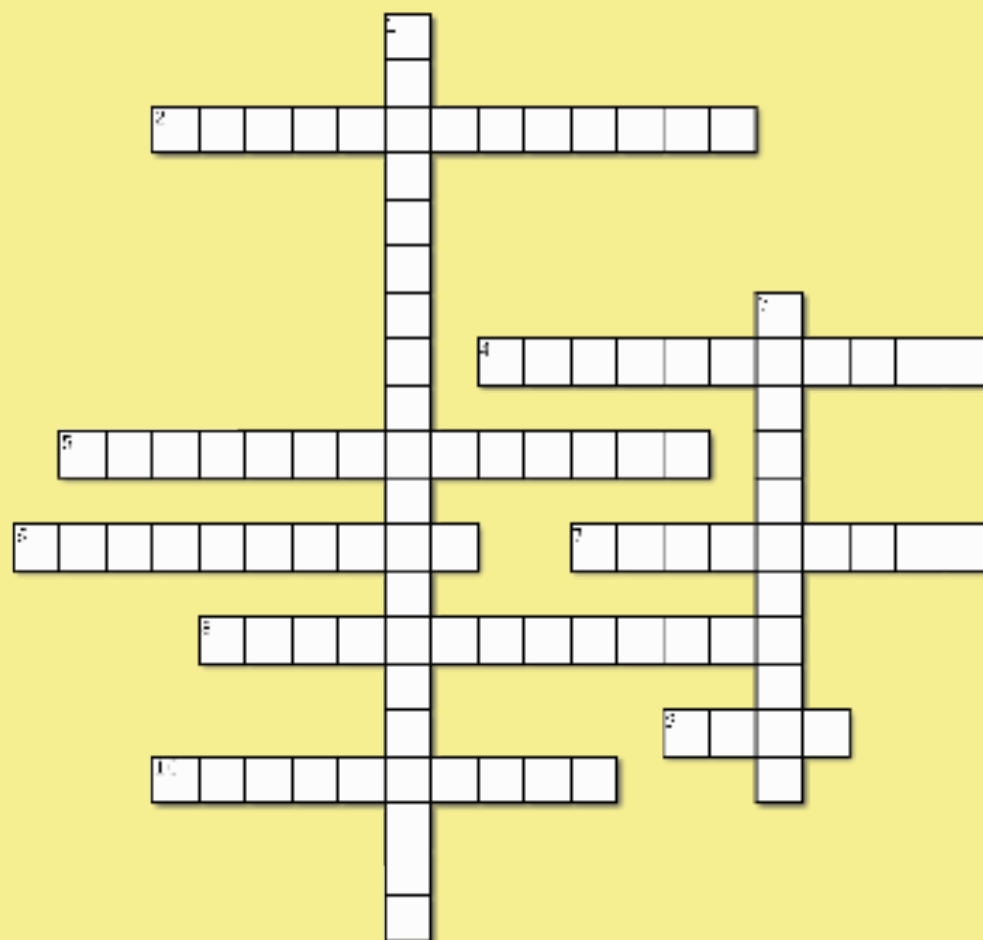
