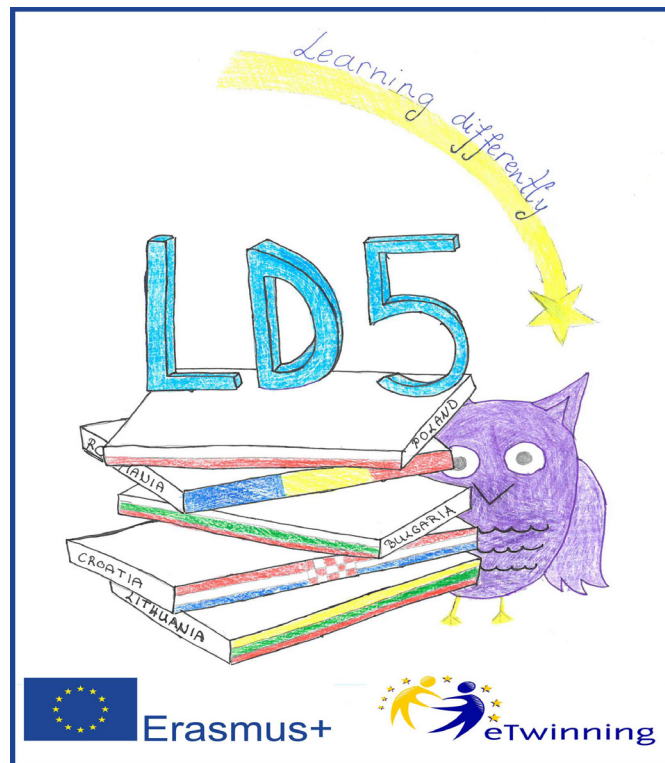

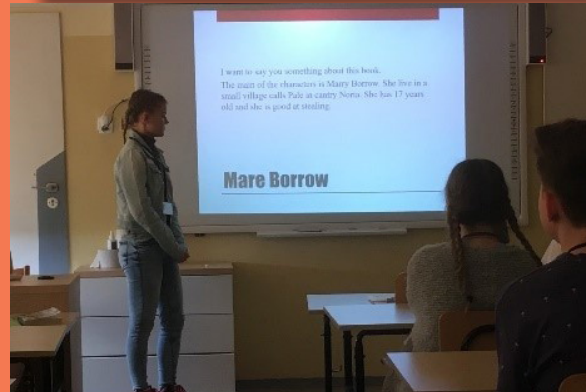
BOOKTALKING

BRITISH LITERATURE LESSON FOR STUDENTS



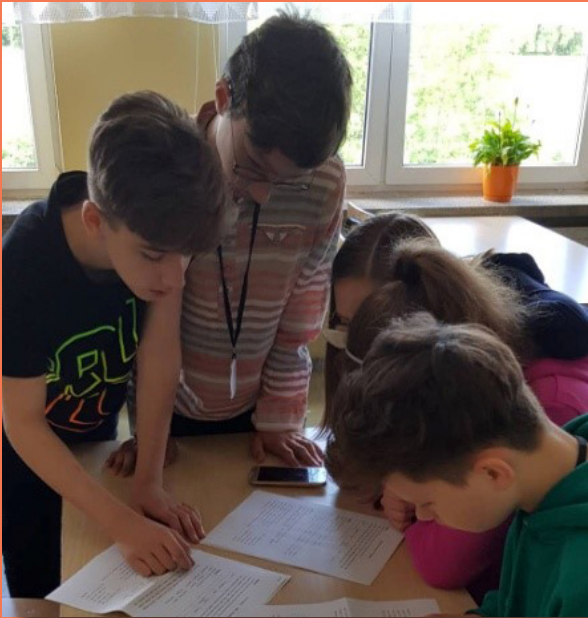
This exercise was awesome! We loved sightseeing Bilgoraj and it really improved everyone's communication.

Balys Sruoga



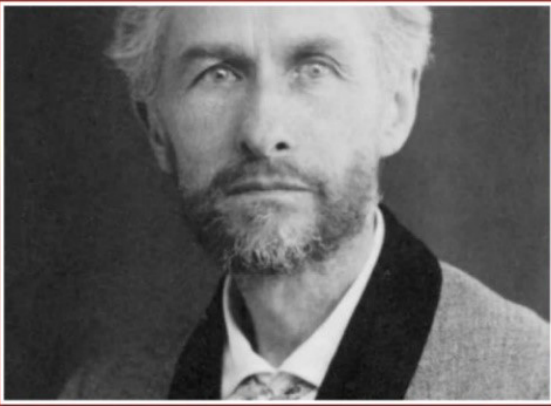
Lithuania

Vydūnas (Wilhelm Strorost) was a Prussian-Lithuanian poet, humanist, philosopher, writer, a leader of the Prussian-Lithuanian national movement in Lithuania Minor. He is best known for his philosophical writings .

Vincas Kudirka



Lithuania

Vincas Kudirka, physician and writer, who did much to revive Lithuanian national and cultural consciousness at the end of the 19th century, author of Lithuania's national anthem.

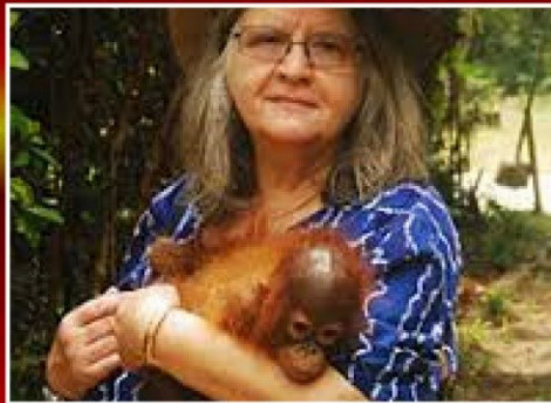
Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis

He was an extremely talented turn-of-the-century painter and composer. His art is symbolical, transcendental, sometimes abstract and often weird and wonderful in the extreme.

Birutė Galdikas



Lithuania

Birutė Galdikas is a well-known primatologist, anthropologist, conservationist, famous for her studies of orangutans. She has a doctorate in anthropology and biology and is the President of Orangutan Foundation International.

Jonas Mekas



Lithuania

He is a Lithuanian-American filmmaker, poet and artist who has often been called "the godfather of American avant-garde cinema". He founded "The Filmmakers' Cinémathèque", which eventually grew into „Anthology Film Archive“ – one of the world's largest repositories of avant-garde films.

Oskaras Koršunovas



Lithuania

Oskaras Koršunovas is a contemporary Lithuanian theatre director, playwright and choreographer. He is one of the few Lithuanians whose name is widely known in the world, especially in artistic circles.

Violeta Urmana



Lithuania

Violeta Urmana is a world-celebrated opera singer, Lithuanian opera diva. For nearly two decades, she has been singing in the most famous European theatres, giving concerts in the renowned halls in Europe, America, Israel, Japan and Russia, often in cooperation with the most talented global conductors and soloists.

Arvydas Sabonis



Lithuania

Arvydas Sabonis is a legendary Lithuanian basketball player whom in 1999 the visitors to the NBA.com website elected as the NBA's greatest impact foreign player. He is recorded in Lithuania's Book of Records being the tallest man - 223, 6 cm.
