The educational system in Lithuania looks almost the same as ours.

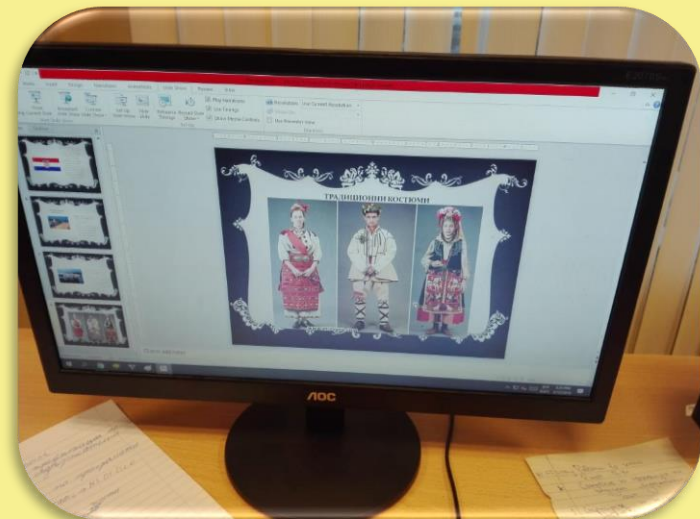
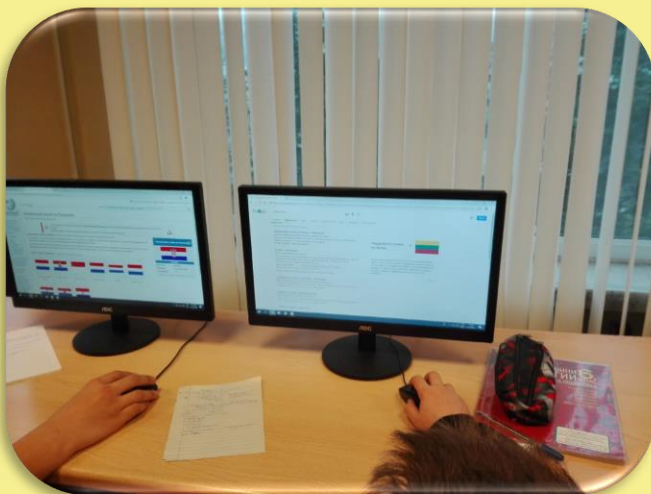
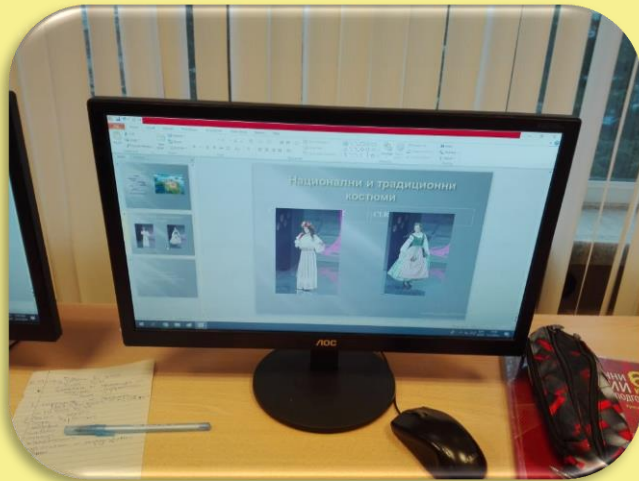

All the educational methods and reading and writing tools we saw are useful and applicable in our school.

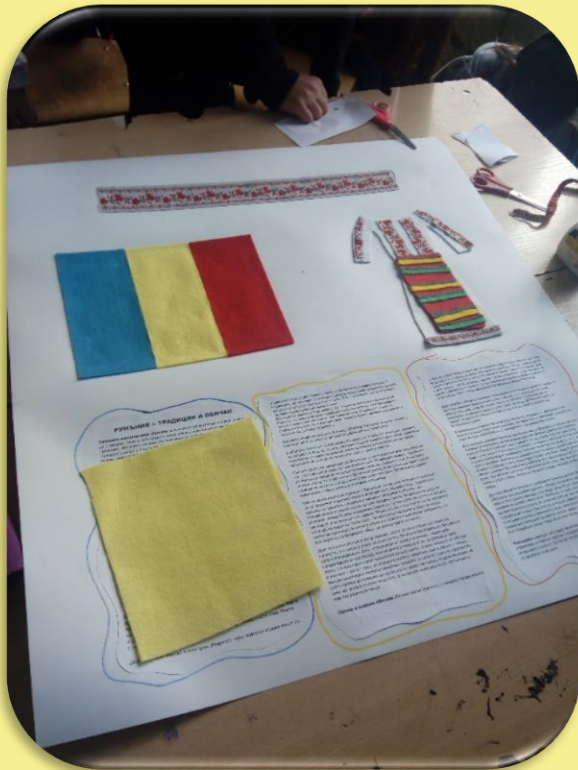
