

Lesson plan

Open lesson for the foreign guests from the Erasmus + project

Class: 6th grade of elementary school - 6 a

Teacher: Emanuela Kuczyńska

Subject: Make a tale - drawing and writing a story about Poland.

Date: 31st May 2019

Aims of the lesson:

- Developing the students' listening, reading and writing skills;
- Acquainting the students with the history and legends of Krakow in Poland;
- Revising vocabulary connected with the legends (e.g. dragon, castle, princess, prince, knight, king, lady, etc.).

Teaching aids: whiteboard, interactive board, multimedia presentation about Krakow, audio recordings, costumes and requisites for actors, sheets of paper, speech bubbles for dialogues, crayons.

Stage of the lesson	Activity	Forms of interaction
1. Engage	The teacher introduces the subject of the lesson and asks the students if they know the history and legends of Krakow. Then she informs them that they will see a multimedia presentation about Krakow, which was prepared by one student.	Teacher with the students
2. Study	The student presents it and tells some interesting facts about Krakow. The students have the opportunity to hear some local melodies.	Students
3. Activate	The teacher asks some questions about the buildings and the sculptures that can be seen in the presentation. After that the teacher invites the students to watch the performance. She asks the actors to act out a tale about the Dragon of Wawel. The task for the students is to watch and listen to it carefully. The actors present the legend.	Teacher and students
4. Activate	The students are to work in groups and read the comics about the legend of the Dragon of Wawel. They are to create completely different ending to the story. They can draw the new scenes and write the dialogues by their own.	Students
5. Follow up exercise	The teacher asks the students to present their works and to read the endings. Each group presents the comics separately.	Teacher and students
6. End of the lesson	The teacher evaluates the work of the students and thanks for cooperation and involvement.	Teacher
