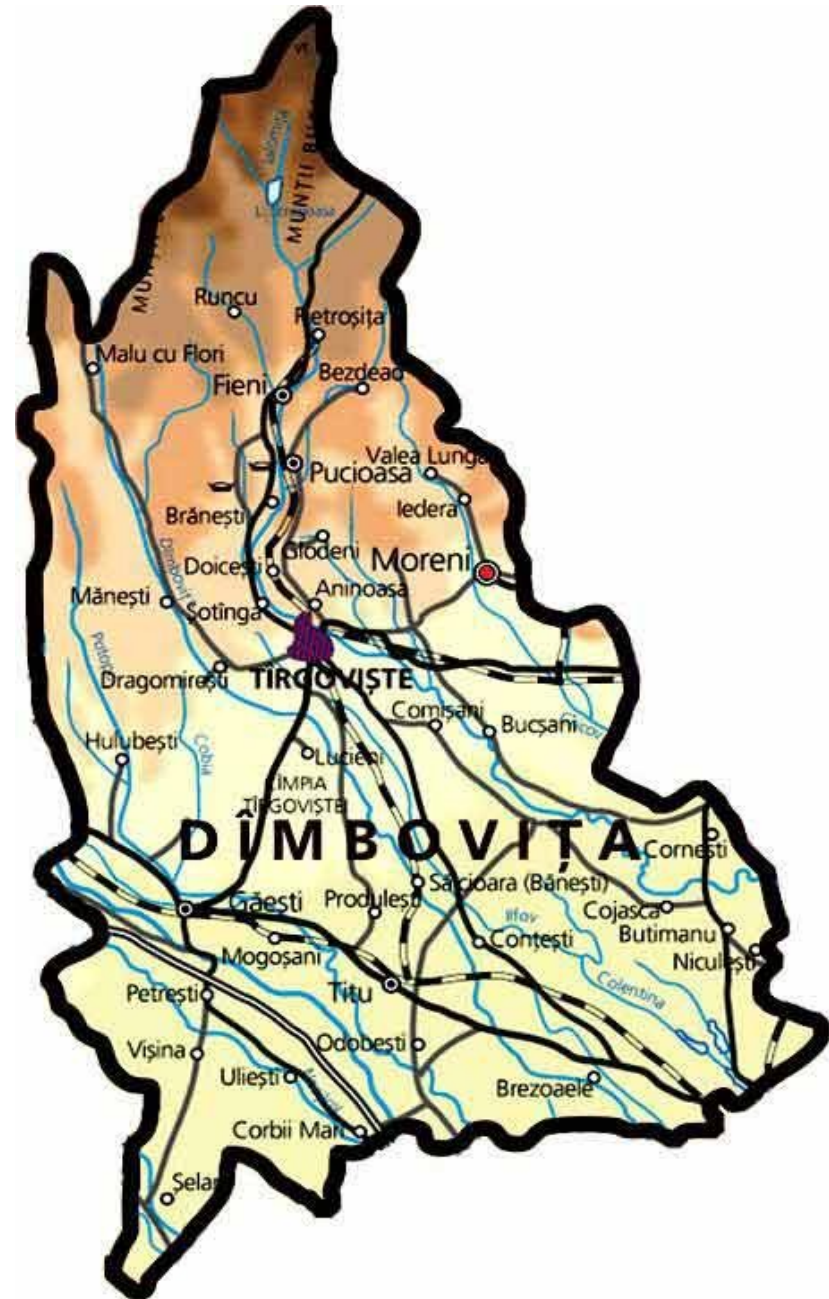


**OUR TOWN:
MORENI**

Moreni is a town in Dambovita County, at about 20 km from Targoviste, the capital of the county.

Numbering over 20,000 inhabitants, Moreni is the second LARGE TOWN of the Dambovita County.

Geographically, Moreni can be located near the intersection of parallel 45 DEGREES NORTH with the meridian 25 DEGREES WEST .



First written testimony about Moreni was on 18. June 1584 when the King Petru Cercel reinforced the propriety of lady Caplea and her nephews Badea and Calota, above the villages Draganesti and Moarile .

In time the village was taken in possession for the Margineni abbey, and then is separated from the abbey by the reform of the king ALEXANDRU IOAN CUZA.

In the same time the Stavropoleos land came into propriety of the peasants who were working the land.

The economical and social life of the city was permanently modified, the most important modification was in 1904 when the first oil-derrick was built in the area.

First written testimony about Moreni village was with the name Moarile (Mills), because at that time in the area were a lot of mills on Cricovul Dulce river. From 1661 the city is known as Moreni . This area became in 1691 the first oil exploitation from Romania, and the third in world.
