TIE AND DYE



1. What is the Tie Dye

Tie and dye is the process of folding, twisting, pleating, or crumpling fabric or a garment and binding with string or rubber bands, followed by application of dye(s).





2. MATERIALS NEEDED FOR TIE AND DYE:


- DYLON FABRIC DYE (hot or cold water dye)
- FABRIC/ T-SHIRT (100% COTTON)
- STRINGS OR RUBBER BANDS
- SALT
- WATER
- BOTTLES



3. HOW TO TIE AND DYE

- Step 1: Put water to boil with a table spoon of salt.
- Step 2: Collect water bottles to mix dyes
- Step 3: Wash the clothes or the shirt and squeeze out leaving it damp with little to no water left in it.
- Step 4: Tie the garments or the t-shirt with rubber bands or strings into the design technique of you choice
- Step 5: Mix your dyes in water bottles colour by colour.
- Step 6 : Pour/ squeeze dye in to the cloth/ t-shirt starting with the lighter colours first.
- Step 7: Let the dye soak for a while
- Step 8: Rinse the cloth or t-shirt under the tap for about 5 mins
- Step 9:cut the strings from cloth or t-shirt then hang on line to dry Enjoy!!

The Shibori is a Japanese manual technique of dying that produces patterns on fabrics


