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




THE MISSION OF TALLINN MEELESPEA KINDERGARTEN:

Establish, through cooperation between parents and teachers, the conditions needed for child's comprehensive development.

Number of groups:	13 (1,5-7. year old children)
Number of children:	265
Number of staff members:	50
Working-hours:	Monday - Friday 7:00-19:00



Our kindergarten has been working for 44 years and has taught thousands of children from Tallinn.

Since 2005 we belong to the **Health Promoting Kindergartens** network. Kindergarten has a certificate to use „Free of Bullying“ methodology.

In Estonia child care institutions are divided into municipal and private child care

In Tallinn we have 144 preschools. 125 of them are municipal and 19 are private.

Preschools are regulated by Preschool Child Care Institutions Act and local government organization act.

Pre-school education is delivered to children between the ages of 18 months to seven years in especially dedicated educational institutions.

In order to establish and keep running a functioning preschool we need:

- Pedagogues, who meet the Minister of Education regulation of child care teachers' qualification requirements.
- Premises and territory with suitable arrangements for children's development.
- A curriculum of the preschool institution which complies with the national curriculum for preschool child care institutions established by a regulation of the Government of the Republic.

Educational management – The curriculum of a preschool institution

The main aim of the early stages education is to support the child's family through fostering the child's growth and development by taking into account their individuality.

The curriculum of a preschool institution which complies with the national curriculum for preschool child care institutions shall be the basis for the organization of learning and teaching in the preschool institution.


The director shall approve the curriculum of the preschool institution on the proposal of the teachers' council after hearing the opinion of the board of trustees.

A preschool institution shall have an activity plan and a daily schedule, upon the preparation of which the national curriculum for preschool child care institutions and the cultural identity and traditions of the area where the preschool institution is located are taken into account.

A preschool institution shall issue a document for the children who have completed the curriculum of the preschool institution, describing the results of development of the child.

What is health education?

WHO- “Health education is any combination of learning experiences designed to help individuals and communities improve their health, by increasing their knowledge or influencing their attitudes.”

Health education in early childhood education

- National Curriculum for Pre-school Child Care Institutions
 - Objectives of schooling and education
 - Based on the common objective, schooling and education fosters the physical, mental, social and emotional development of children as a result of which the children develop a comprehensive and positive self-image, understanding of the surrounding environment, ethical behaviour and initiative, basic working habits, physical activity and understanding of the importance of taking care of one's health and play, learning, social and self-management skills develop.
 - Principles of schooling and education
 - to take care and promote a child's health and to satisfy his or her need for movement;
 - to take into account the individuality and development potential of a child
 - to foster a child's creativity;
 - to create an environment which promotes the development and socialisation of a child
 - cooperation between home and the child care institution;




Health education in Tallinn Meelespea kindergarten

Vision of the kindergarten: Tallinn Meelespea kindergarten is a child friendly, health promoting, safe and creative environment.

The mission of the kindergarten: Establish, through cooperation between parents and teachers, the conditions needed for childs' comprehensive development.

We have specialists: art teacher; physical education teacher; music teacher; swimming teacher; special education teacher (part time); speech therapist (part time) and highly educated teachers and mentor for teachers.



Versatile development environment

The kindergarten has created a versatile development environment where the child can actively play and select various actions to take part in.

It is very important for us to focus on developing child considering all the aspects of health, including mental health.



Emotional health

Positive, respectful and caring attitude toward others.

Increase the “we are one” feeling in group.

We believe and want each children to feel that they are special the way they are.

Developing a positive self-esteem.

Different recreational activities during the day and after.



Physical activities

We have a physical education teacher.

Every autumn and spring all the groups from the kindergarten celebrate sports day.

According to the early childhood curriculum we have 1-2 times a week physical education activities. One is indoors and other outdoors.

Since 2017 we have a renovated [swimming pool](#) where kids from age 3-7 swim 1-2 times a week. Swimming lessons are conducted by our swimming teacher.

Our teachers as well like to be physically active- take part in different sport events, have a traditional autumn and spring bog trip to where we invite our kindergarten children with their parents as well.

We like to go to the nature a lot.



Healthy food

We have our own kitchen and cooks.

Children love to cook something healthy for the anniversaries.

“Good person gala” to 5-6 y old children (from each kindergarten 1 group of 6 children will participate)


