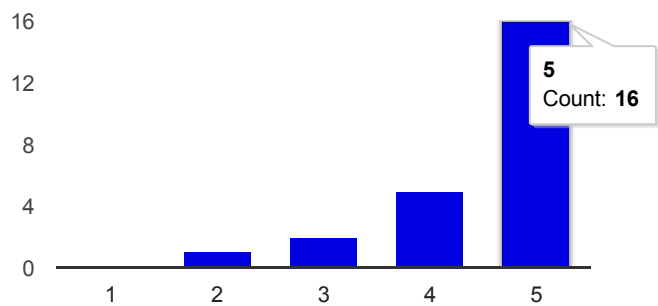

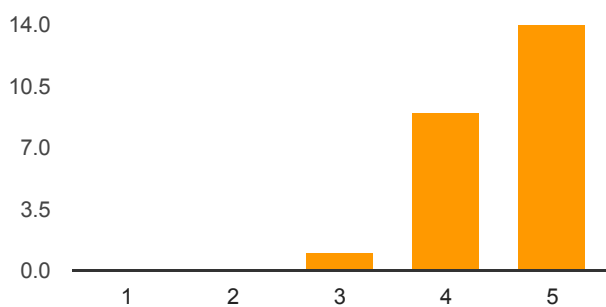

1. I got actively involved in the preparation of the meeting in our school.



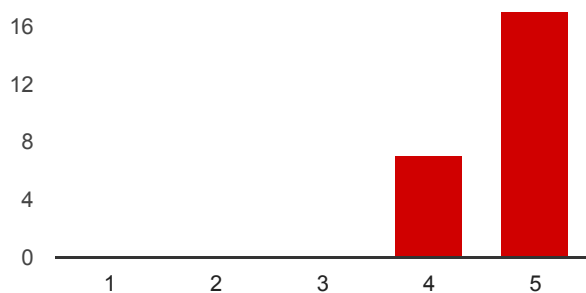

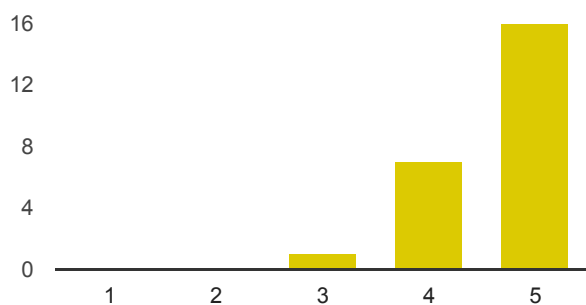

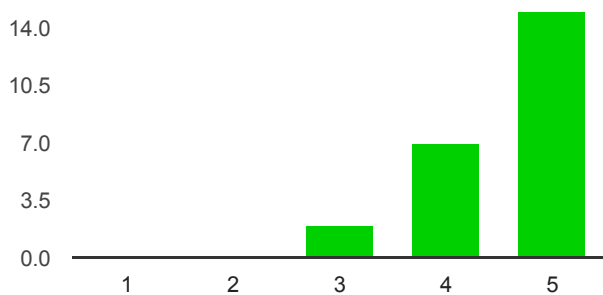

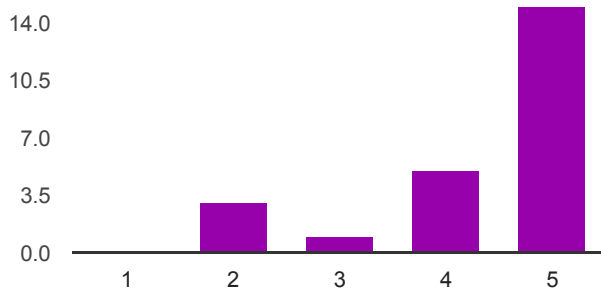

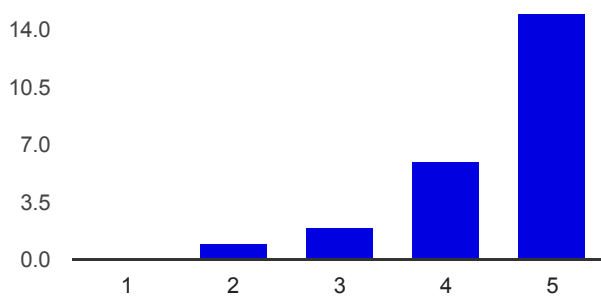

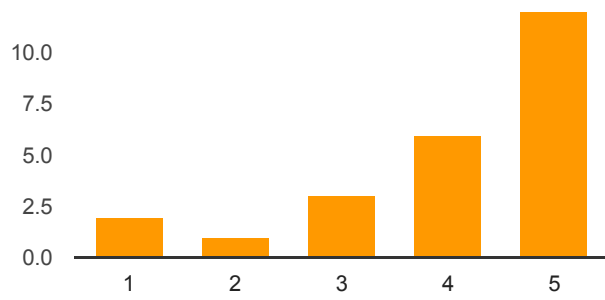

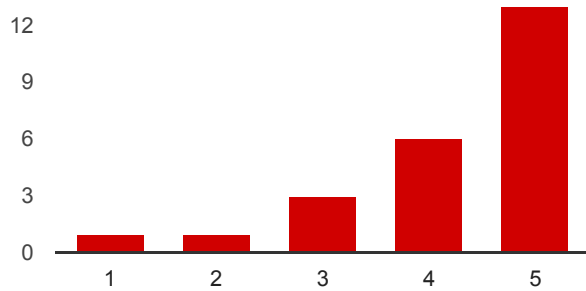

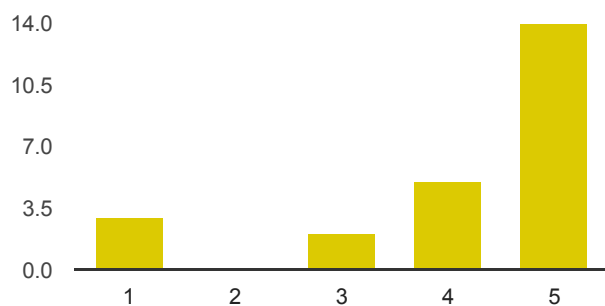

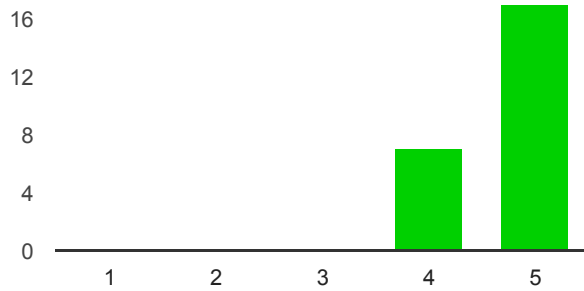

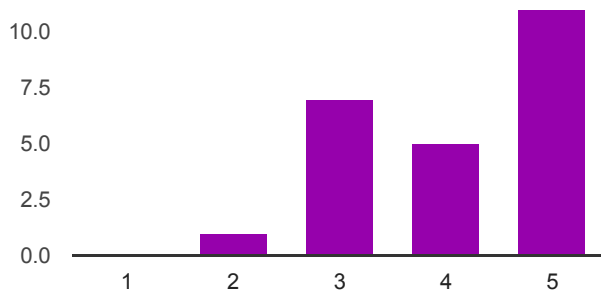

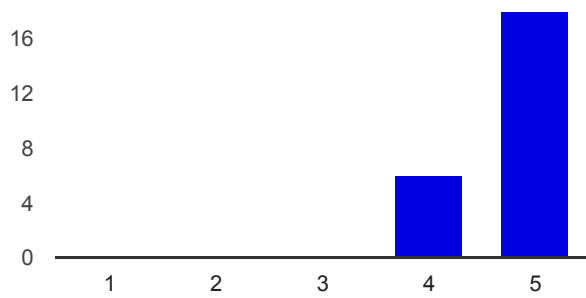

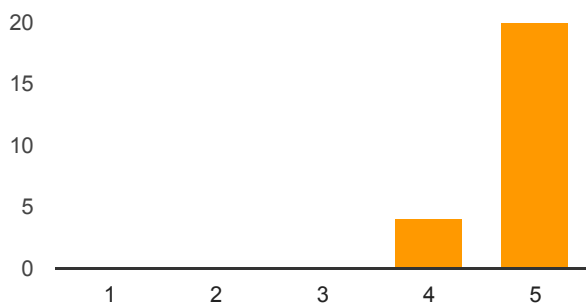
