


1. Goal:

a) Connect to your google account

Go to Firefox web browser and connect to your google account

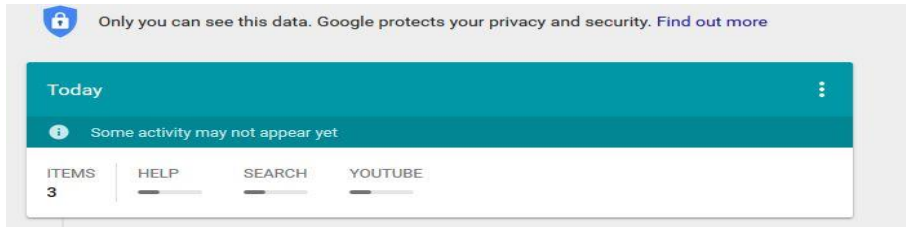
At the bottom, there are two more sections:

Location History

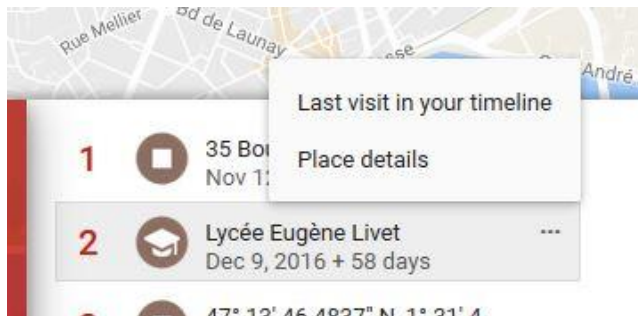
Your timeline in Google Maps displays your Location History, the private map of where you go with your signed-in devices. You can edit places and delete all or part of your history.
