

What can you find in Gyomaendröd?

Gyomaendrőd is a quiet calm and small town in south-east Hungary. 17 thousand people live in this town. Long time ago Gyoma and Endrőd were

different places. Gyoma is 300 years old this year. The location is fantastic, because next to the town there is a river called Hármas-Körös. Our town has got 4 churches: Szent Imre Catholic Church, Jézus Szíve Catholic Church, Reformed Church and Gyomai Evangelical Church. The are some museums: Endrődi Country House and Local History Collection, Gyomai Country and Creative House, Fisher and History Fun Park, Kállai Ferenc Memory Exhibition, Kner Printing Industry Museum, Papp Zsigmond Memory House, Rózsahegyi Kálmán Collection, Vidovszky Béla Local History Collection and Town Picture Gallery. The town has got a thermal bath and spa called: Liget Thermal Bath and Camping, but we have got 2 free beaches.

In this town there are 3 elementary schools: Rózsahegyi Kálmán Elementary School and Student Home, Szent Gellért Catholic Elementary-, High School and Student Home and Kis Bálint Elementary School in Gyoma. 2 secondary schools: Bethlen Gábor Agricultural and Food Industry High School and Student Home. Opposite of it there is Szent Gellért Catholic Elementary-, High School and Student Home in Gyoma. In the centre there is a pub called The Bell. Young people in the town often go there to meet, talk and dance with their



friends. It is a popular place. In The Bell sometimes people watch the latest movies. It is called Moving cinema. The people are very nice and helpful in Gyomaendrőd."
