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## **MINUTES 22: WORK TEAM MEETING OF PROJECT “HARRY POTTER AND THE CASE OF THE SICK EARTH”**

### **1. ITALIAN MOBILITY**

We started the meeting talking about the trip to Italy and valuing the possibility of its realization. All the participating schools agree, so **the mobility to Italy is finally set for the week of Monday, April 4 to Friday, April 8.**

It is programmed all countries arrive in Italy on Sunday, April 3, and initially leave on Saturday, April 9. The Spanish school comments on the possibility of traveling back to their country on Friday the 8th in the afternoon, since the activities scheduled for that day will end soon, due to the flight schedules available between Spain and Italy. There is no major problem, even if necessary, the Italian coordinators agree to adapt the Friday schedule so that everything can be done jointly between the four countries.

There are certain changes in the lists of participants from Romania and Spain. Throughout this afternoon, each person in charge will send the correct lists to the Italian coordinator so that they can send us the invitation letters duly prepared, signed and sealed tomorrow.

Also due to these changes in the participants, Romania informs that they will change the reservation of rooms in the hotel to two triple rooms. They have already contacted the hotel and there is no problem. The Spanish team has certain doubts with the number of accompanying teachers, as soon as they solve them, they will notify the hotel and confirm the reservation. They will also keep the Italian team informed.

The restrictions to enter and move around Italy are discussed again. There may be changes at the end of March, but nothing is certain. We can confirm the data by reviewing the Italian government website.



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We also talked about the transfer from the airport to the hotel. The best way from Naples airport is with a taxi. For Greeks arriving in Rome it is better to take a bus.

The mobility program remains the same, without changes. Finally, the Italian school that welcomes us will bear the costs of transfers between activities as well as the necessary tickets for museums, gardens, palaces... As agreed at the beginning of the mobilities. There is also a comment on the security data, which the Italian coordinator will send us tomorrow.

And they inform us that they have been authorized to carry out the solidarity market in person, so they will begin to organize it in the coming days.

They also comment on the possibility of receiving us on the day of arrival at the hotel and on the possibility of having dinner together on said days. We all agree as long as flight times allow.

The Italian school tells us that they are preparing the rules for the game of Quiditch that we will do in one of the workshops. When they have written the rules they will send them on to us so that we can explain them to the students in our mother tongue, although of course they will be explained during the activity.

## **2. STUDENTS VIRTUAL MEETING**

The virtual meeting of the students will take place **at 6 pm** on Thursday, March 17. It will be a Meet video call organized and led by the Italian coordinators. At this meeting the students will be able to introduce themselves and begin to get to know each other.

Each Italian student will be paired with two guest students (Spanish, Romanian and Greek; trying to mix the countries) Since 7 Italian students participate against 14 guests (6 Spanish, 4 Romanian and 4 Greek) The pairs will tell us on Monday 14 March, before the meeting so that the students come with an idea. They can prepare a Power Point presentation to introduce themselves, or just talk, whichever they prefer.

## **3. NEXT MEETING.**

All the members agree to have the next teacher's meeting on Thursday **31<sup>st</sup> march**, at 6 in the afternoon (Spanish hour) by Google Meet. The planned action points are:

- Final details of Italian mobility (as weather, clothes, restrictions of COVID, time of flights arrivals, Sunday dinner...)
- Rumanian mobility: final decision on its realization and dates, documents necessary to travel, mobility program, letter of invitation from participants...
