W1 The Cooperative game of the QUIDDITCH Tournament with the first two games in which the four houses will face each other: *Gryffindor* against *Hufflepuff*; *Ravenclaw* against *Evergreen*. The winners of the first game will challenge each other.

It will be an ice break activity to let the students know each other and feel comfortable within the team and school.

W2 Creative Lab: Nature becomes art. Students will be able to create objects/pictures with the only use of natural materials (stones, leaves, pieces of wood, cereals...) thus experimenting a new relationship between man, art and nature.

W3 Sensory Visit to the English Garden of the Caserta Royal Palace, looking for "Treasures". It'll engage the basic 5 senses of sight, smell, sound, touch and taste in order to connect with nature and become more aware of the surroundings.

W4 Open air Games to encourage rediscovering individual/group competitions, which keep kids active and strengthen their physical development (muscles, bones, coordination, blood circulation...). They can boost Children's creativity and help them acquire social skills.

W5 Ancient Roman children's games. Students will be encouraged to develop the sense of cultural heritage and practically understand differences and similarities between their life and the ancient Roman kids' one. The Roman life and some of the children's games will be explained on site, in the old buried town of Herculaneum, covered by Mount Vesuvius lava in 79 A.D., when Nature overcame life. reflect on the Force of Nature.

W6 lava stone collection / group work with photos. Students will collaborate, observe, analyze and collect lava stones on Mount Vesuvius, a still active Volcano.

W7 -The old site of "Calatia" with Prof. Lidia Vignola. An archaeologist and a teacher who will give voice to an ancient precious area in our province, poisoned by tons of toxic waste.

Expected results:

- Tangibles: objects made at school with natural materials. Mobility photos and videos collection. Mobility assessment document. Mobility minutes.

- Intangibles: improvement of the European dimension of the participants.
