1. ERASMUS ACTIVITIES

- The activity of the solidarity market has already been carried out by Romania, Spain and Greece. The Italian school needs to do it. They had it scheduled but they had to cancel it because of the rain. They are remaking it.

- For the month of April we plan to celebrate Earth Day (April 22) with the recording of announcements by the students, in which they talk about the environment and its care.

- In addition, before April 28, we agree that the articles of the magazine must be sent to the project coordinator (Tania) in text document format (Word). They do not have to be very long. You must indicate who is the author of each article and add an avatar of the boy or girl.

- To end the month, students can comment on what they think of all the activities carried out in this Erasmus project in a collaborative Padlet. They have to sign with their name and school. And we can all also see the opinions of others.

- The coordinator recalls that before tomorrow, April 1, all the countries must complete the project's monitoring activities. Italy, Greece and Spain have already finished it. Romania is missing this section.

2. ITALIAN MOBILITY

We begin by commenting on the day of arrival of each country. The Italian team of teachers offers to welcome us and accompany us on the day of arrival.

- The Romanian team is scheduled to arrive on Saturday, April 2, and they have booked an excursion to Capri for Sunday, April 3.
- The next team to arrive is the Greek team on Sunday, April 4, they are expected to arrive at San Nicola la Strada around 4 in the afternoon.
- The Spanish team lands at the Naples airport on Sunday too, but at 7:20 p.m., so they will probably arrive at the hotel around 8:30 p.m.

After assessing it, it is finally agreed that the Italian team is in charge of organizing Sunday dinner at a pizzeria near the hotel at 9:30 in the afternoon. Leticia, Matilde, María Antonieta and Valeria will accompany us.

Next, we will review the activities scheduled for each day and explain certain changes in the schedule.

- ✓ On Monday we start with Matilde who will wait for us at the hotel reception at 8:15 in the morning. We will walk to the school (it takes approximately 30 to 40 minutes) There everyone will receive us and welcome us.

At 10:30 we will be received by the mayor of San Nicola la Strada. Returning from the town hall we will stop at a small museum where we will take a break with a small appetizer organized by the families of the students of the Italian school. When we get to school we will play Quiditch (first workshop).

At 2 noon we have a reservation to eat at a pizzeria near the school. The price is 10 euros per person (includes pizza and drink) At the end we will go back to the school and we will be honored by the school orchestra. And to end the day we will have the second mobility workshop at the school.

- ✓ On Tuesday we will spend the day in Naples accompanied by Letizia and Matilde. We will enter the Teatro San Carlo. The food is reserved in a pizzeria with a menu of 12 euros (pizza and drink)
- ✓ On Wednesday we will spend the day in Caserta accompanied by Marie Antoinette and Valeria in the morning. Matilde will probably join us in the afternoon. That day we will eat a picnic (you can pick it up at the hotel or buy food) and we will carry out workshop 3 and 4 scheduled.
- ✓ On Thursday we will go to Vesuvius and Herculaneum and we will carry out workshops 5, 6 and 7 if the weather allows it. They recommend wearing comfortable and old shoes because the volcanic rocks stain a lot. In principle, lunch with a picnic is also scheduled.
- ✓ Friday is the final day. We will stay at the school and sign the necessary papers and certificates. Lunch is reserved at the pizzeria next to the school (10 euros per person) We will finish soon because the Spanish have the return flight that same afternoon at a quarter to 8. The Italian team recommends leaving San Nicola La Strada around 5pm to avoid transfer delays.

Regarding the new entry regulations in the country, today they have lowered the conditions since the state of emergency in the country has ended. In principle, with a PCR 24 hours before or the Green Pass is enough.

They ask that all teachers carry the card that identifies us as such to be able to enter museums, palaces, theatres... The Spanish team has already sent a copy to the Italians. They will take the sealed, signed and laminated original to the trip. Two accompanying teachers from the group will pass for free and the Italian Erasmus will pay for the tickets of the others. It would only be necessary to pay the entrance to the San Carlos Palace, which is 4 euros per person as we agreed in a previous conversation.

It is also requested that we carry signed authorization to take and publish photos of students during mobility. We will have to deliver a copy upon arrival in Italy.

3. ROMANIAN MOBILITY

In this meeting it is agreed to go ahead with the mobility scheduled for the week of May 9 to 14 in Romania. Greece and Spain will attend in person. Unfortunately, due to the war situation in Ukraine right now, bordering Romania, the Italian team informs that it has not obtained authorization to travel to this mobility. So, it is decided that they will participate when they can online.

From now on, the invited countries will begin all the procedures, and the Romanian team will modify the reservations and activities to adapt to the new situation. As of Monday of next week we begin with the documentation of this new trip.

4. GREEK MOBILITY

It is accepted among all the members of this team to continue with the mobility to Greece in the week of May 30 to June 3. In principle, the three countries (Romania, Italy and Spain) will attend in person.

Greek team recommend booking the hotel first, as those dates are already high season in Greece. The program of activities is already prepared and they are in the process of transport. They will send all the data starting next week. Greece already has the questionnaires for the Spanish and Romanian students, it lacks the Italian ones.

After Easter holidays the COVID regulations in the country are expected to change, as soon as they have the new information, they will tell us. Now we can start buying flights and travel insurance.

5. NEXT MEETINGS.

All the members agree to have the next teacher's meeting on Thursday **28th april**, at 6 in the afternoon (Spanish hour) by Google Meet. Also, we agree to have the student's meeting on Tuesday 3rd may, at 6 in the afternoon (Spanish hour) by Google Meet. In this meeting students can introduce themselves.
