




PBL in our schools

Whole **school** works on a topic:

- need for high coordination
- need for an accurate organization of (time and space)
- high impact on results

Tutor + specialists using integrated lesson plans:

- need for some coordination
- shared timetable

- some impact on results (same group)


Same teacher using integrated lesson plans:no need for coordination


- organizes your own time

- Coexistence atmosphere






Students will learn to be more self-sufficient and responsible, since they are they ones in charge of their own learning.

- Students further develop their skills, and by putting.


Learning Pyramid





