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


Our first meeting took place in Spain in November 2018 and it was an amazing experience. We had so much fun and made new friends, saw beautiful sights, tasted new food...

**Havířov** is a medium- *sized* town in Moravskoslezský kraj in the Czech Republic . It was built in 1955 and is located in the Moravian-Silesian industrial area (Ostravsko-Karvinsko).

Havířov is located at the confluence of the Sušanka and Lučina . In the north it borders on the mining regions Petřvald , Orlová and Karviná , in the west on the

municipalities Šenov and Václavovice. The landscape is slightly hilly and intersected with brook and river valleys. From the west to the east the landscape crosses the railway connection and trunk road Ostrava - Svinov to Český Těšín. A densely populated residential area runs along the trunk road.

It was great to see a beer production place inside. The brewery was too small so half of us were playing outside.


### WEDNESDAY 3rd April 2019






#### FRIDAY 5th April 2019








#### Tuesday 24th September 2019

On Thursday we got up early and we went to the ice cave. It was a fantastic experience, We could see the ice in the cave and beautiful nature.


Then we went to štrbské pleso, and even it was just for a while, it was really nice and the view was beautiful




Virtual mobility in March 2021

Firsty, they presented their country Romania with a presentation, also they showed a beautiful school. We saw an interesting video about Romania and we loved Romanian traditions so much!




We had a chance to learn something about Romanian culture. Great kahoot, movies showing Romania and their school.




We loved playing Kahoot and we think it was a really good way to starting the week






Interview with American student was very interesting, we learned a lot of new information about America. Jade told us about the school system in America, racism, religion and life in Arkansas. She answered all of our questions.

# Wednesday 24th March (PL)


In the morning we started the day with a presentation about Poland, Kashubia and Puck. We have learned a lot about this region and important issues like discrimination, unemployment and intolerance.












We also had an incredible presentation about gender and why we should accept the others for who they are. Also managed to learn about what we should do to help the people who are still trying to find themselves and support them.




#### Friday 26th March (ES)

#### Monday 31st May 2021

After we met up at 8:45 a.m in front of our hotel we went to the Polish school to learn more about the history and culture of Puck and Poland itself. The presentations started with a musical introduction that traced the experiences of Polish people during the War times and in regime after the war. Our time in the building of school slowly came to an end and we divided into smaller groups. One went to the Puck glass blowing business and the other had a workshop with mosaics. After that lovely experience we had a city game. Puck, even if it's not the biggest city, is a certain one to look at. We had many stops. The docs, town square or interesting statues. With a map in one hand and mobile phone for photos in the other we ended the day on a pleasant note.

#### Tuesday 1st June 2021

Our day started in Jastarnia. We got on the bus at 8:45 in the morning and then traveled towards Hel.

We got to rest on the beach near Kópc Kaszebów, and then we continued on with our trip to dinner, which was accompanied by people in traditional Kaszubian folk costumes. We also got to taste some traditional Kaszubian food and tobacco. After dinner we had free time and got to dance to music with other students, which we all enjoyed.

We arrived at our hotel at about 11 p.m. and got ready for the next day.






#### Wednesday 2nd June 2021

Hence, we explored the outstanding city Gdańsk, we saw various tenement buildings and the St. Mary's Church.





At 12am we went to the school and we were writing the newsletter. After we finished, we went out to eat dinner at the "Na Molo" restaurant.






Then, we went sailing on a boat around the Puck Bay. Afterwards, we went to a bowling alley.
