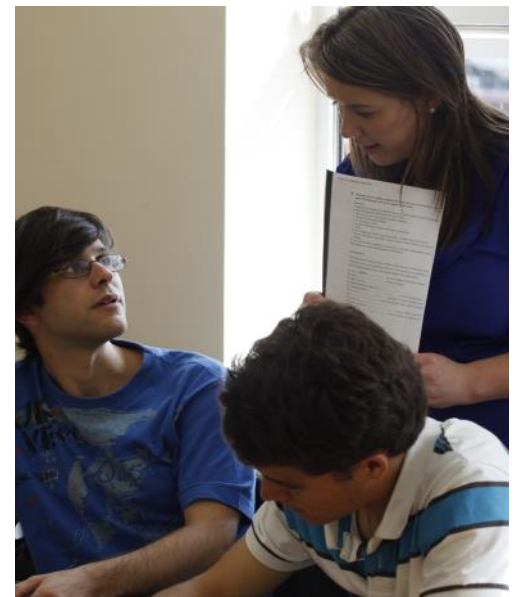
# Intensive General English - AE107B
