

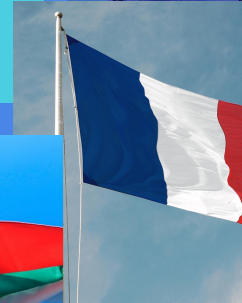
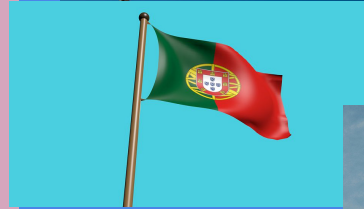

She is packing up and waiting for her big adventure. She hopes to find a job to get experience and make a living.

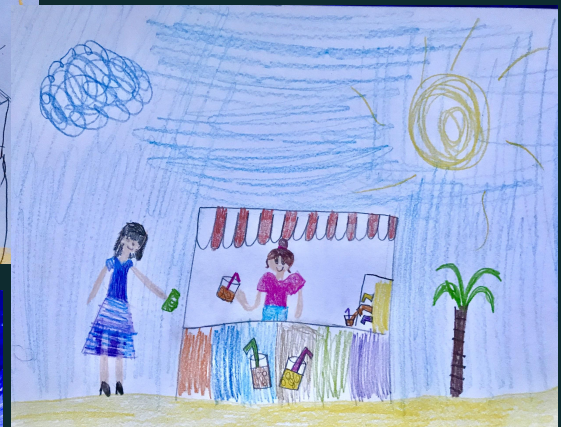
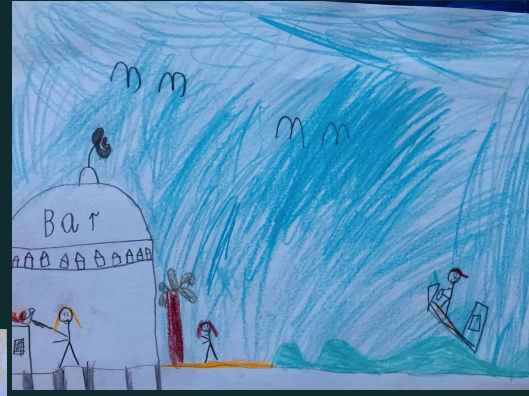
Eva chooses to go to Majorca in Spain.

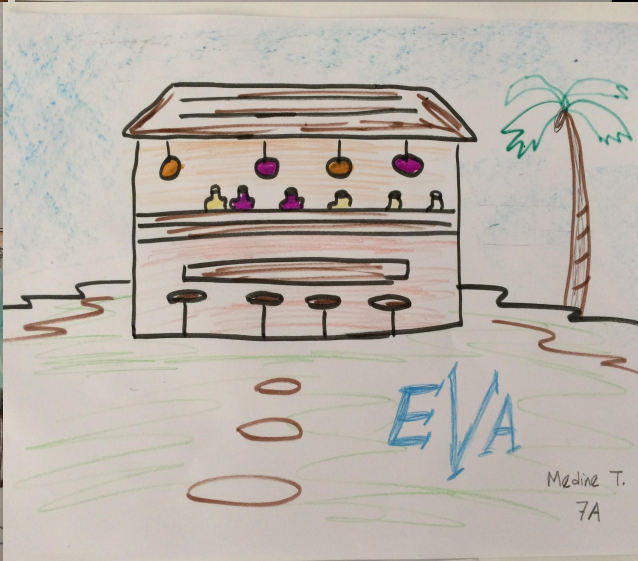

Eva was very suprised, she wore her apron without knowing what to do and she started working...



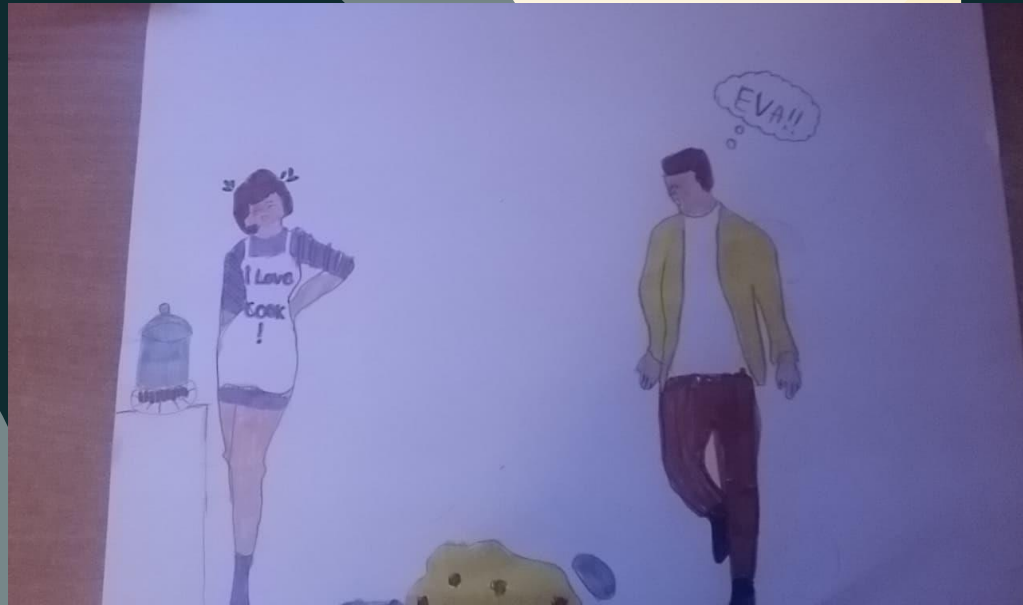
