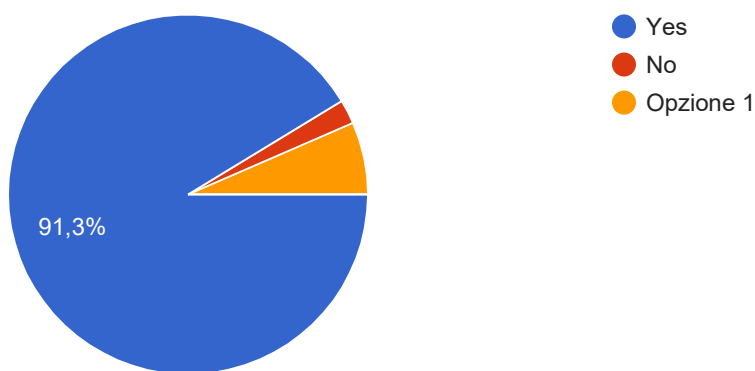

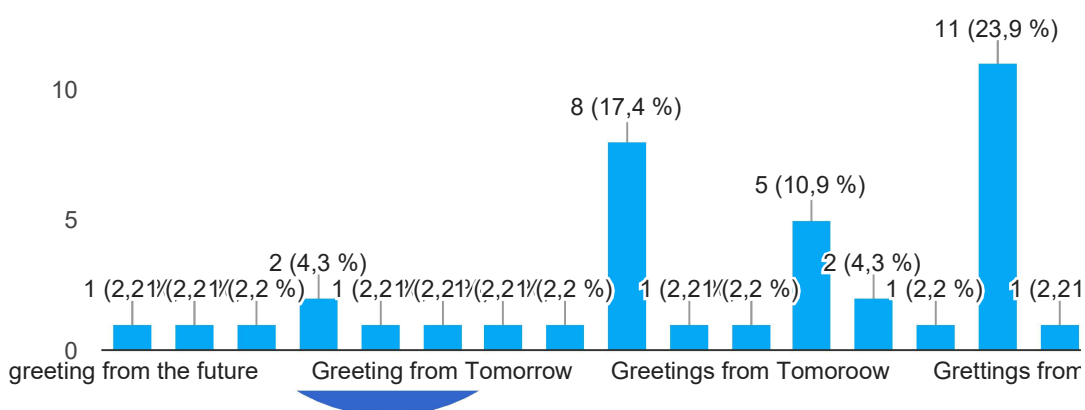

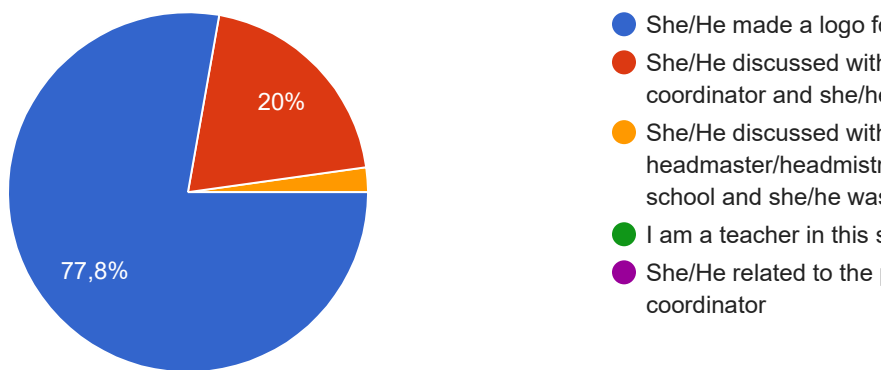

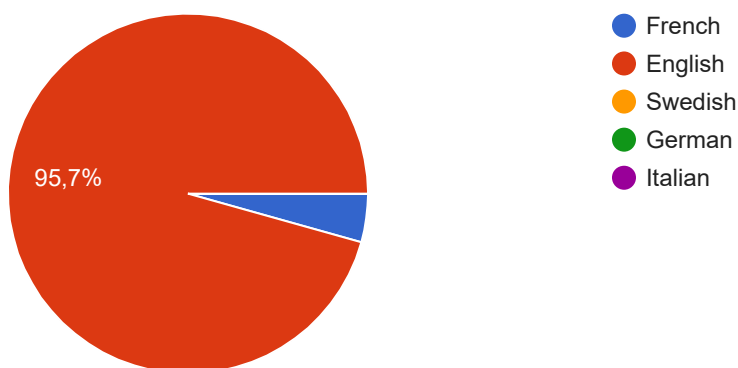

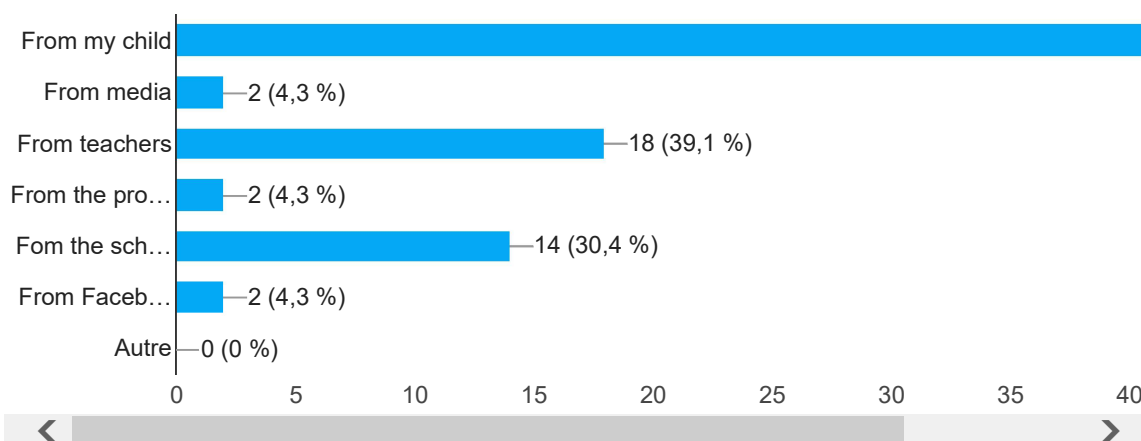

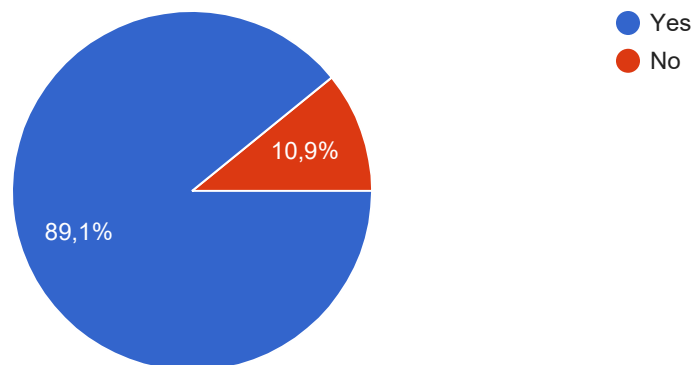

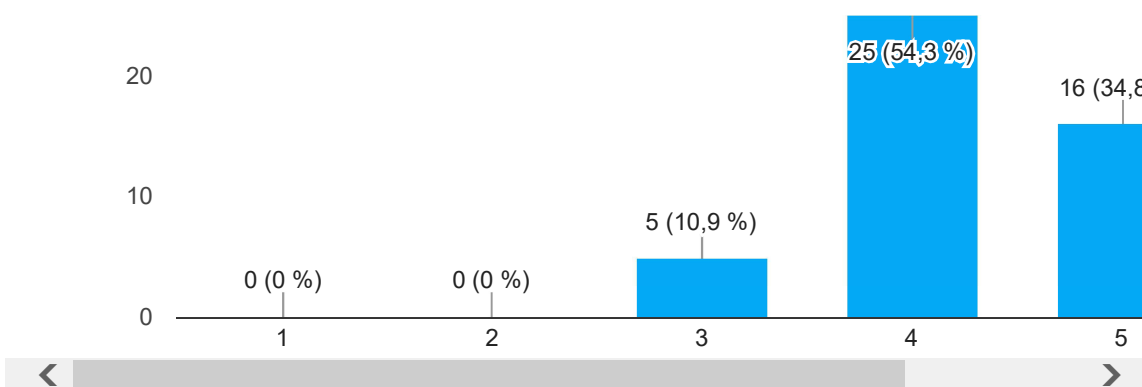

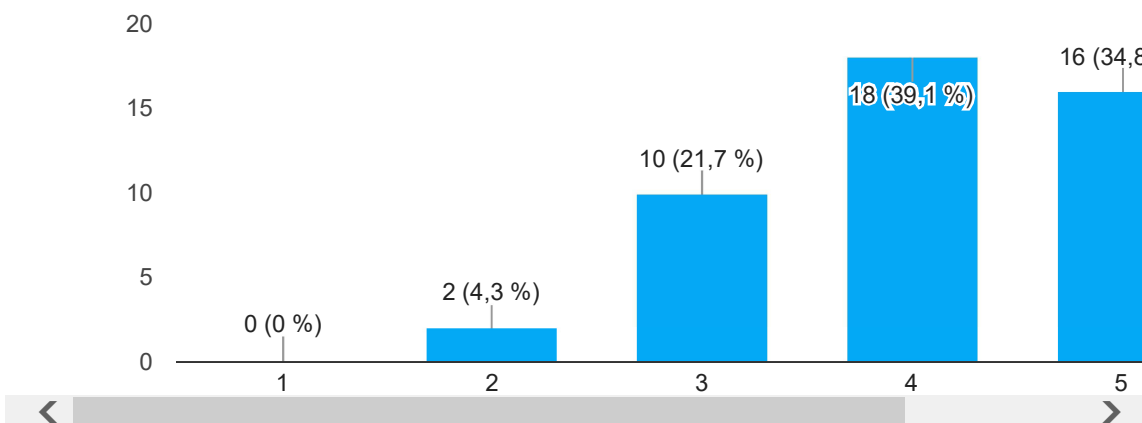
13. How do you think this project will contribute to your child's personal development? - Rate on a 1 to 5 scale the increase of his/ her general knowledge -

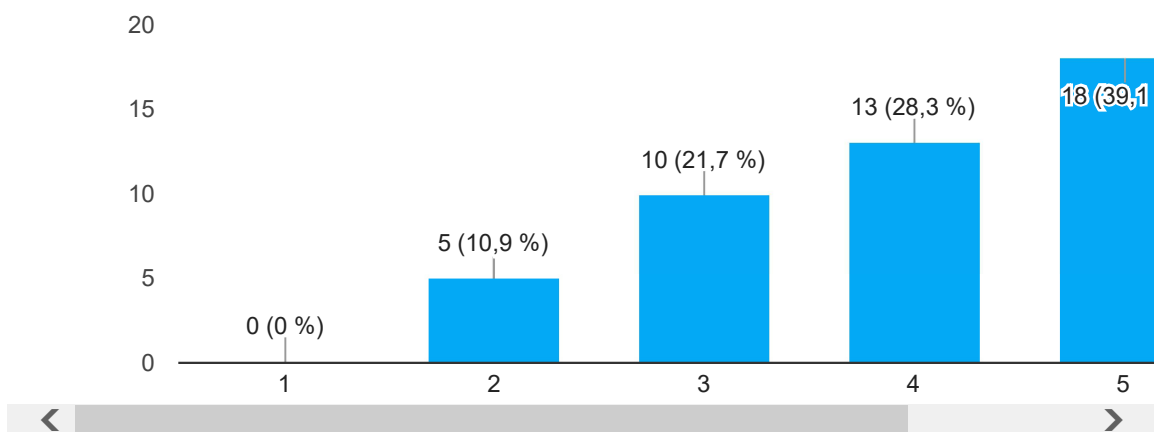
Rate on a 1 to 5 scale the improvement of his/ her linguistic competence

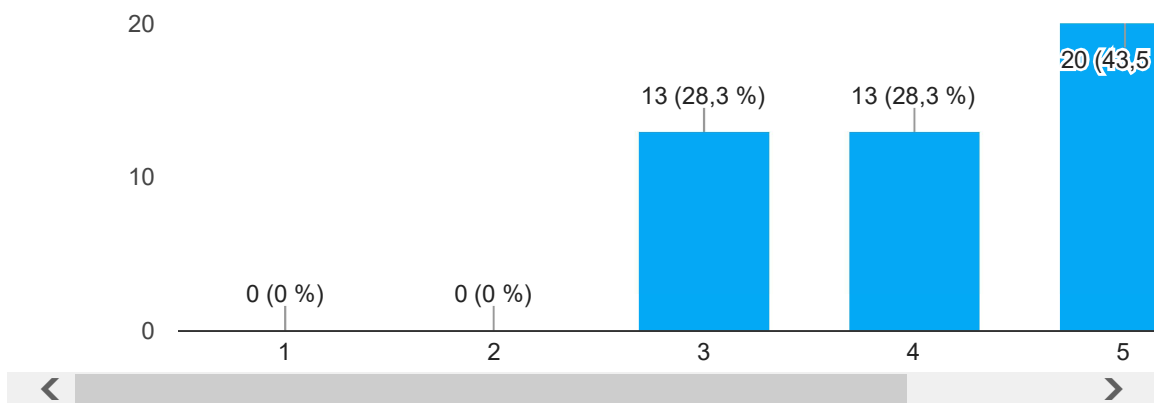
Rate on a 1 to 5 scale the improvement of his/ her ICT skills
