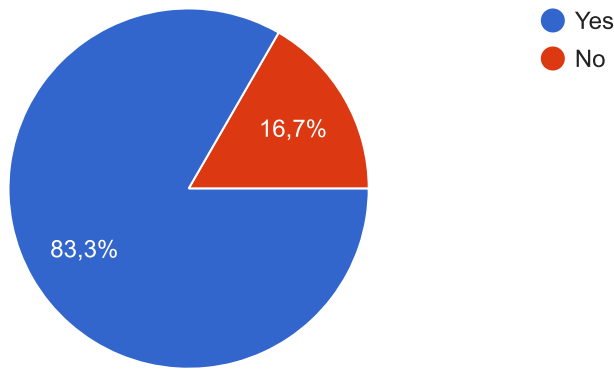

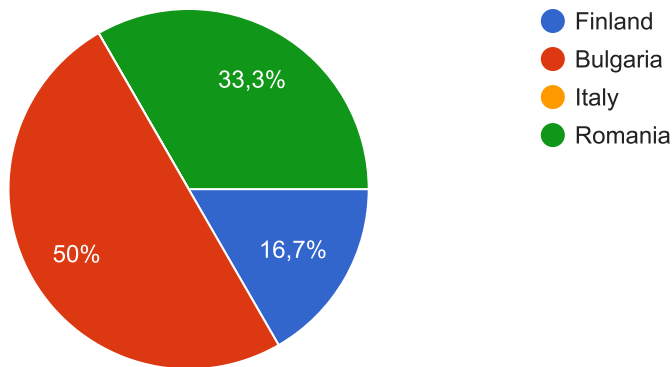

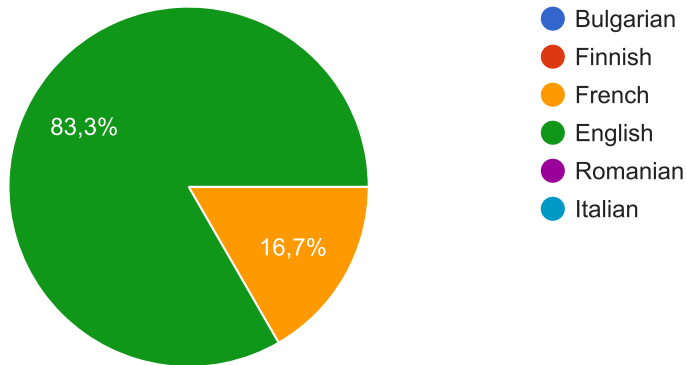

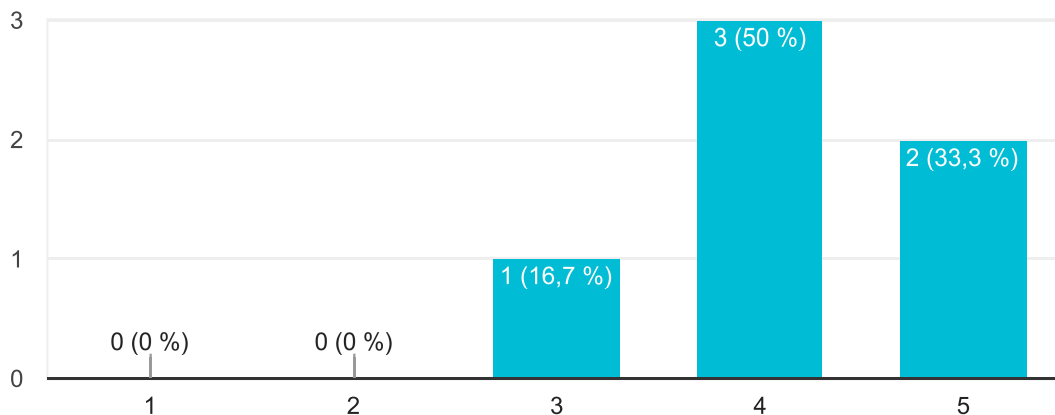

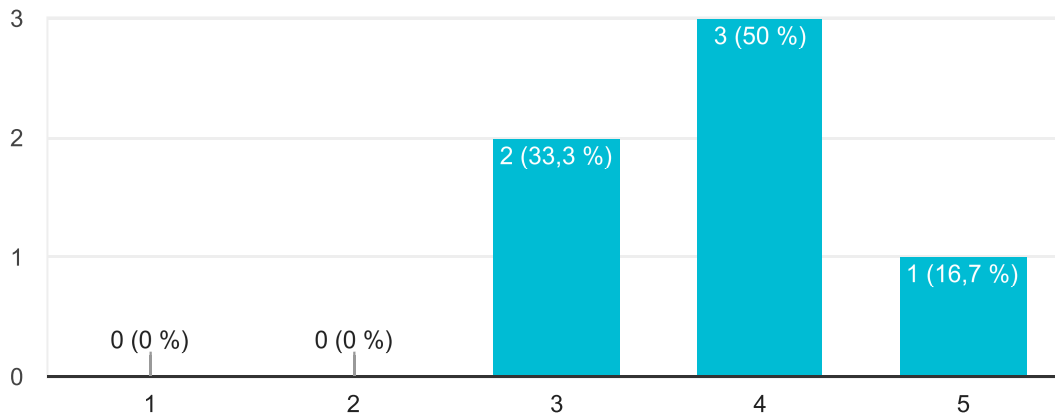

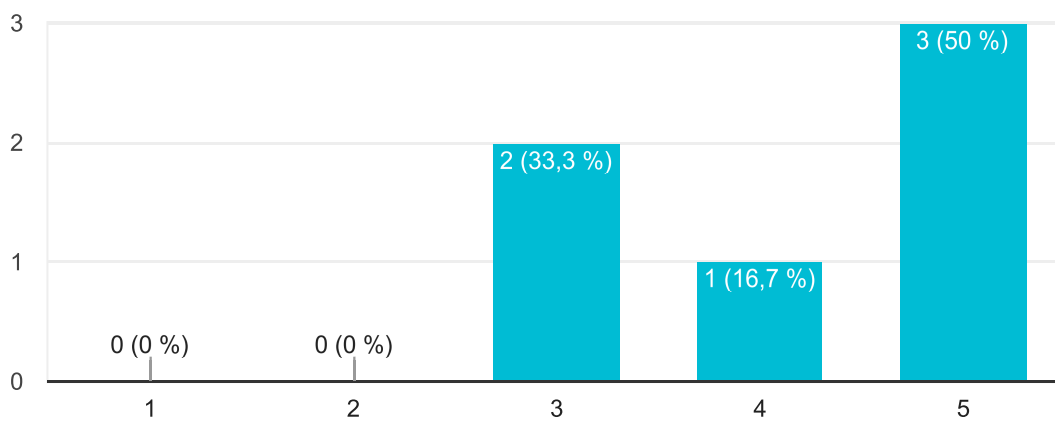
Rate on a 1 to 5 scale the increase of his/her general knowledge

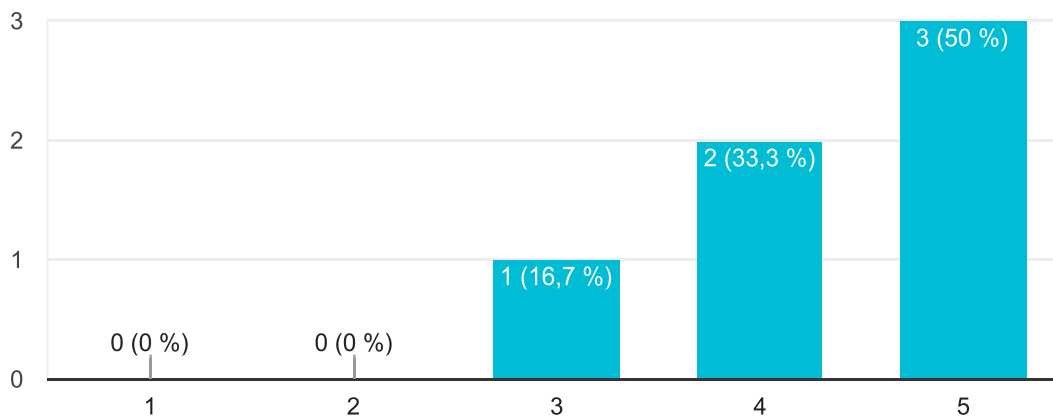
