

Location

Our school, IES David Buján, is situated in **Cambre**, a municipality in the Province of A Coruña, in the autonomous community of Galicia in northwestern Spain. It lies 12 km from the capital city of A Coruña and ten minutes away from the city's airport, Alvedro.

According to the 2010 census, the municipality of Cambre has 23,621 inhabitants spread throughout its 12 parishes, which occupy 41 square kilometres.

The town is situated on the Way of St. James (Camino de Santiago), though on the English Way (Camino inglés), used mainly by pilgrims coming from England and Ireland via ship to A Coruña or Ferrol, and from there on foot to Santiago de Compostela.

The town of Cambre has many places of interest. Among them are:

The Church of Our Lady Mary of Cambre (Spanish: Iglesia de Santa María de Cambre, Galician: Igrexa de Santa María de Cambre), built around the 12th century; an archaeological museum with a permanent exhibition of the remains of Roman baths and latrine; and the house of Galician writer <u>Wenceslao Fernández Flórez</u> (1885–1964).

Our School: IES David Buján

At the IES DAVID BUJÁN, we teach the following age groups and special programs:

- Secondary Education (pupils aged from 12 to 15)
- SixthForm (pupils aged 16 and 17)

Ours is a school with a special focus on:

1. Promoting language learning and language diversity. (We currently teach Spanish, Galician (our regional language), French and English) Both Maths and Science are also taught in the English language to 12 and 13-year-old pupils(bilingual sections)
2. Helping students to acquire basic abilities in life. Our centre is also noted for our "Health Workshop Programme", which started in 1991 and covers extra-curricular activities, the emphasis being on Health Education, as this is one of our school's best-known features. This year we have been taking part in a school health program, "Xplore Health", designed to create and promote a website interlinking other schools (as well as scientific learning centre and museums) with the aim of enhancing the spread of knowledge in health research.
