Reporter 1	So let's start with education in Latvia. What can you tell about education of Latvia?
Reporter 2	The Latvian education system consists of pre-school education, basic education, secondary education and higher education. General education in Latvia in total lasts 12 years consisting of compulsory 9-years basic education and 3-years secondary education. Additionally pre-school education at age of 5-6 is compulsory in Latvia.
Reporter 1	I think that education is very important for choosing your future job and big influence on that what salary you'll get. There are some people who left their studies and because of luck now they are earning millions but there are only a little of them.
Reporter 2	I think it's necessary to mention that in Latvia and our school, same as in all European Union ,kids participate in different projects , to diversify the learning process and help kids expand their view on world.
Reporter 1	Important topic in world now is the modern technologies and how they affect the children and their learning process.
Reporter 2	Sometimes they are needed and very useful but using them too much can create addiction and actually difficult and disturb the learning process.
Reporter 1	Now let's talk a bit about education in European Union.
Reporter 2	EU countries are responsible for their education systems, but the EU helps to identify common objectives and spread best practices. The new program "Erasmus +" intended to combat unemployment among young people by helping them improve their skills

	and employability.
Reporter 1	European Union Youth Strategy is to promote equal opportunities for young people in education and employment of the United Nations encourages them to be active citizens.
Reporter 2	The program will help more than 4 million people (mainly young people) to study, practice, gain work experience or to volunteer work abroad. It also helps more than 125,000 organizations to cooperate with similar organizations abroad, in order to innovate in the United Nations, modernize the teaching methods of the United Nations in work with youth.
Reporter 1	At last about our school projects. Our school is engaged in European Union education, training, youth sports United Nations program "Erasmus +" supported within the project Make:Learn:Share:Europe
Reporter 2	The project aims to promote and develop students' digital skills and create sustainable education for pupils in these skills after the completion of the project, to provide in-depth knowledge, international experience and practical action-based ICT learning in schools, demonstrating the use of the acquired knowledge and efficiency on a daily basis, thus creating interest choose ICT sector studies and future profession, while encouraging also in mathematics, science and foreign languages.
