Vasil Aprilov

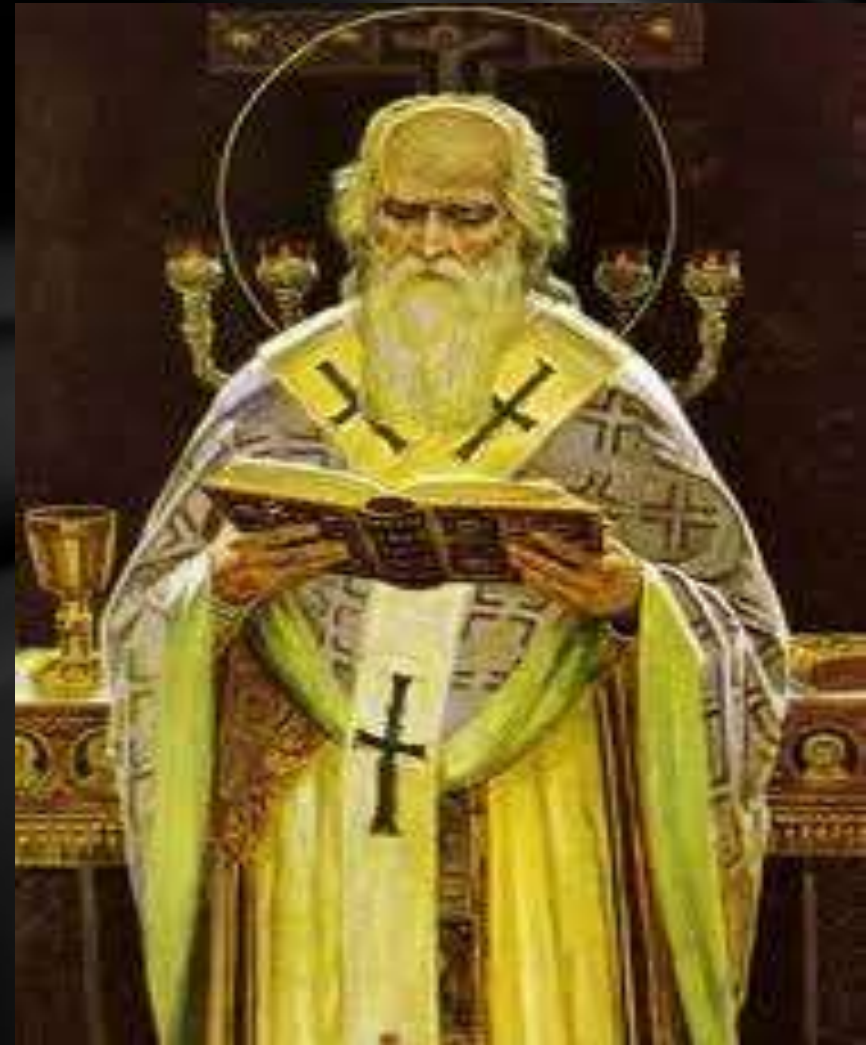


Kliment Ohridski
