

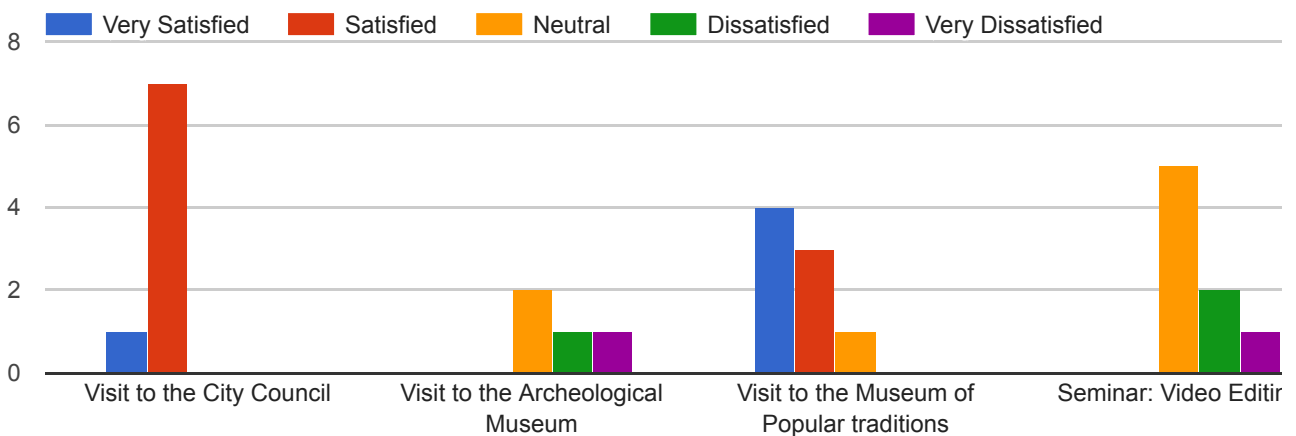

The visit to the necropolis was not prepared in a way for us to wear the right shoes which made it difficult. I realise this is not a cultural exchange but if we are shown around it would be nice to learn more about the places we see. Finally, dealing with money every day several times was too time-consuming and troublesome - it would have been nice to pay in one sum. And finally, I know we have discussed this but we didn't have the financial information ahead of time, which is what we agreed on. All in all, it didn't cost more than Greece, but it felt like it did.

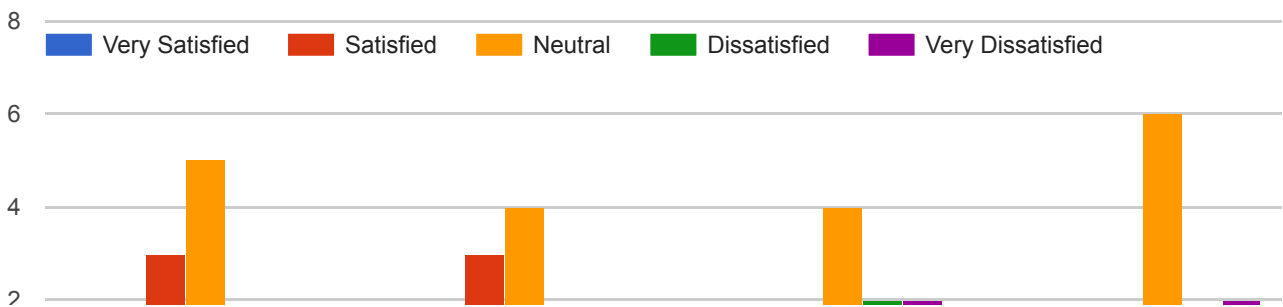
Better organisation.

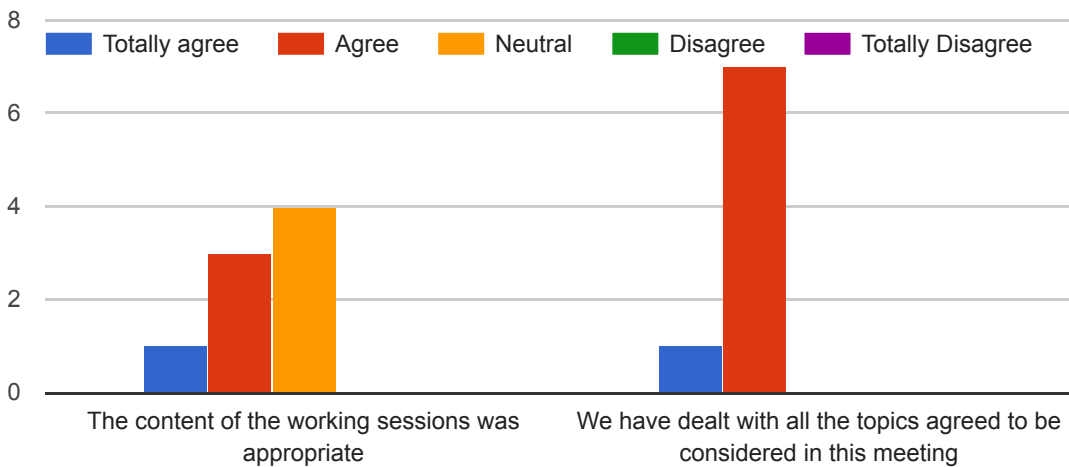

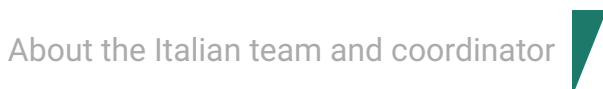

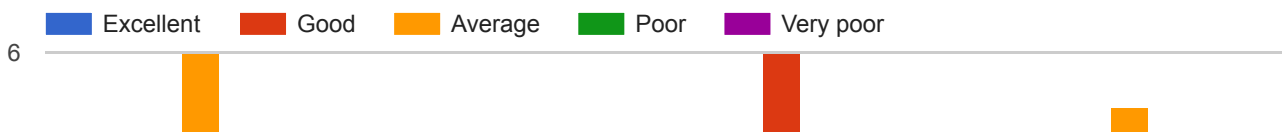

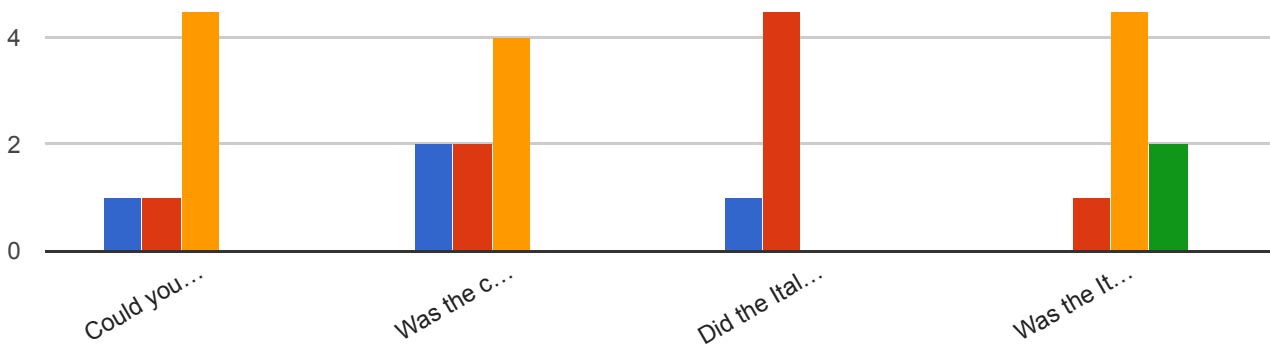

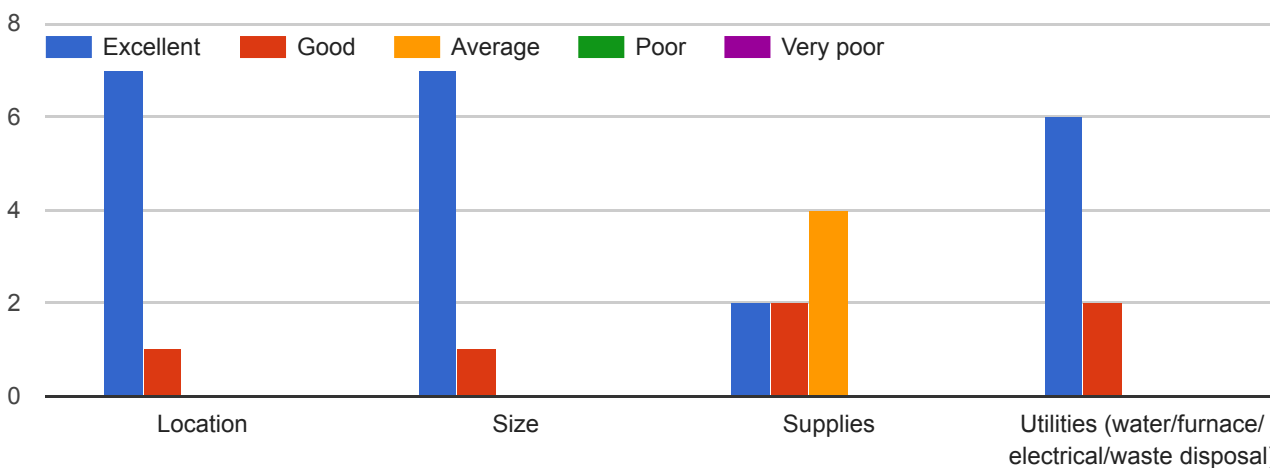

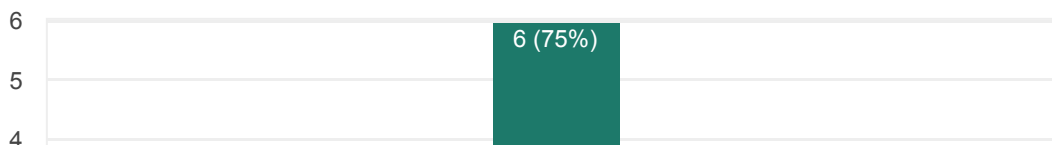

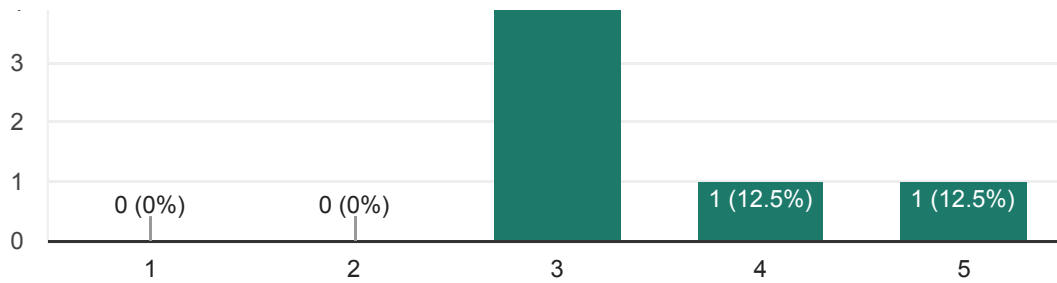


General rating of the Italian meeting

Some lack of organization when meeting for activities or starting them at the appointed time

LACK OF CLARITY AND PRECISENESS IN SOME OCASSIONS AND LACK OF PUNCTUALLITY

Timing and schedule planning. The Italian team didn't support the coordinator and she was left alone to deal with all the aspects of the meeting, which is impossible to do. The coordinator did the best of her nevertheless.

Organisation. The program was excellent, otherwise.

First of all, I would like to comment on the fact that the schedule of the mobility in Italy did not arrive in time. As for the activities regarding the students, these were too limited and also there should have been a kind of welcome- warm up game which is pedaqoqically appropriate in projects like Erasmus+, involving

communication and interaction among students.

Moreover, there were inconveniences regarding the hospitality of students in some cases.

Finally, there was no internet connection which should have been taken into consideration before booking the rooms.

There was no prior information whatsoever about the necessary gear required for the scheduled trips in the area, so both teachers and students faced problems and discomfort.

There were no warm up activities for the students to know each-other.

There was no proper internet connection.

The activities for the students were limited.

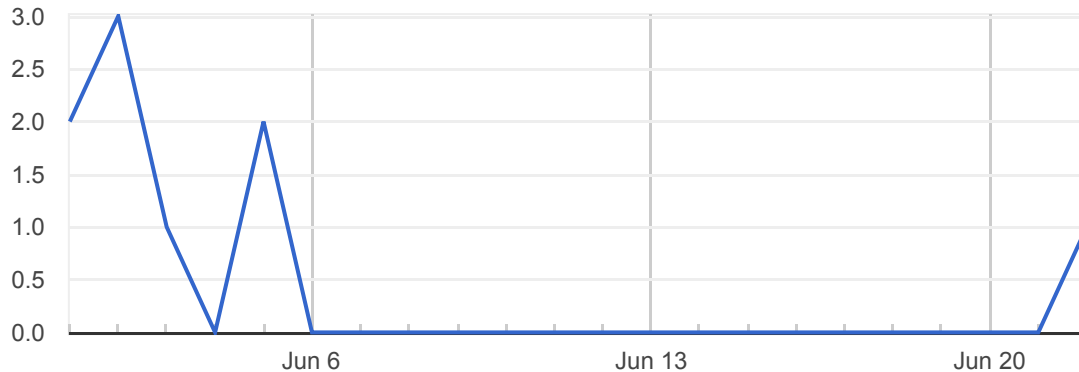
The activity programm did not arrive on time.
