



ZOBOR TRANSMITTER

Hill Zobor is only 556 m high but it is visible from a long distance and all directions because its surroundings are flat lowlands.

The Zobor transmitter is a radio and television transmitter. It is located directly above the town of Nitra, on the Pyramid, the pre-peak of Zobor in the Tribeč Mountains. It is Nitra's typical landmark and its antenna can be seen from everywhere in the town.

In the 1980s, a mast was built on Zobor, from which a television signal was transmitted. A significant dimension was also used as an important node of RR routes, so the construction of a communication tower in the early 1990s was logical. The reinforced concrete tower was completed in 1993 and is one of the newest facilities of its kind in Slovakia.
