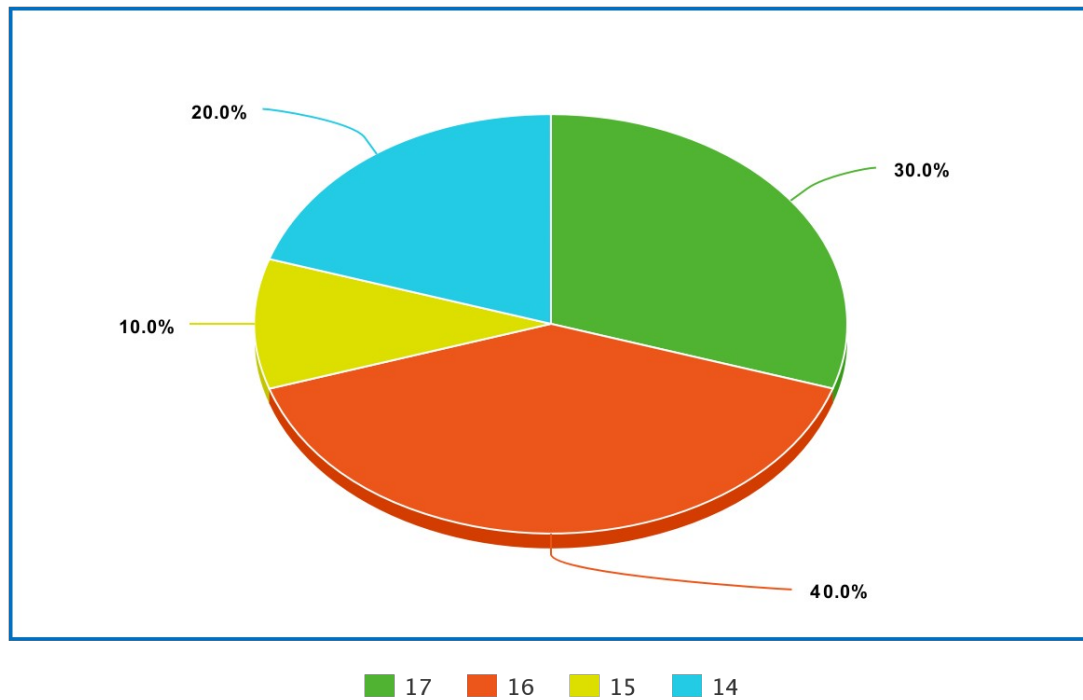


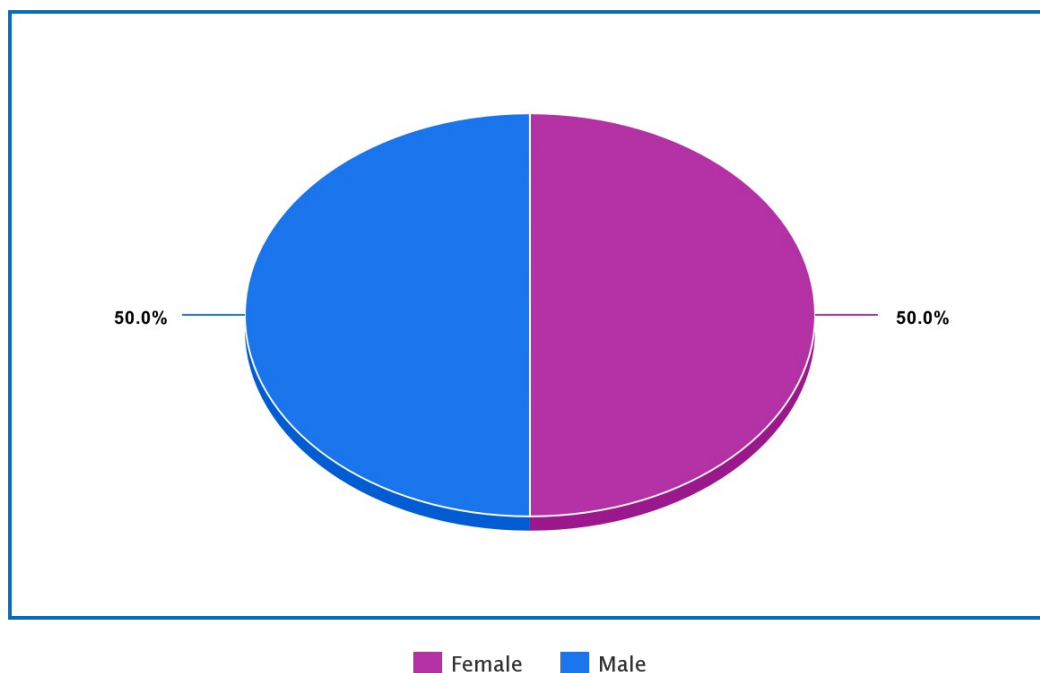

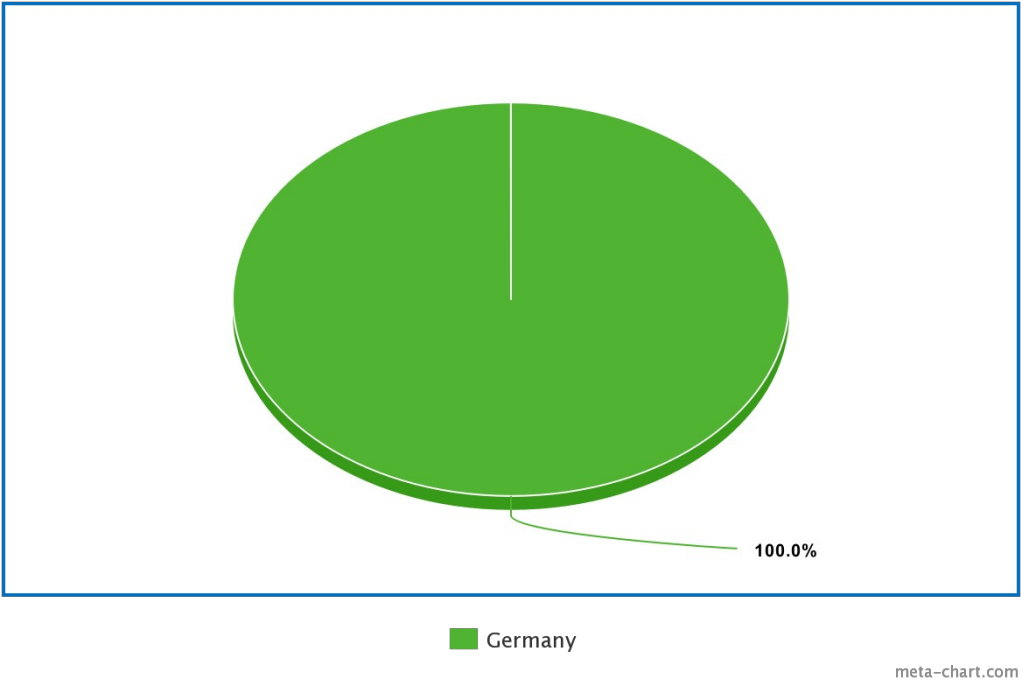

2. Gender

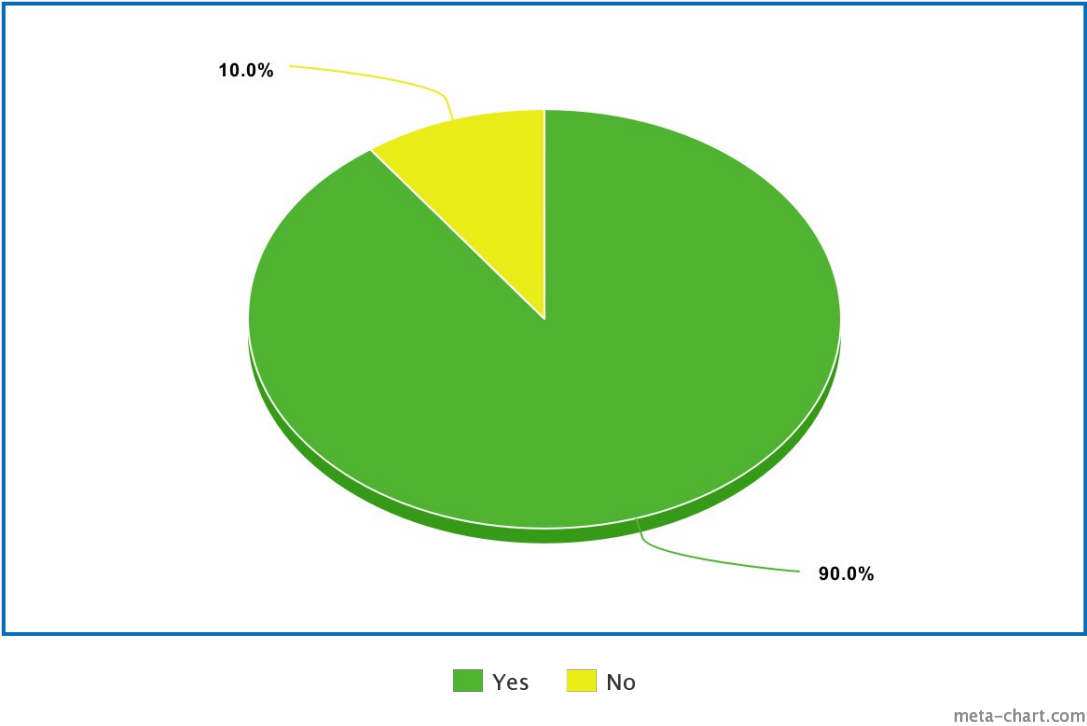

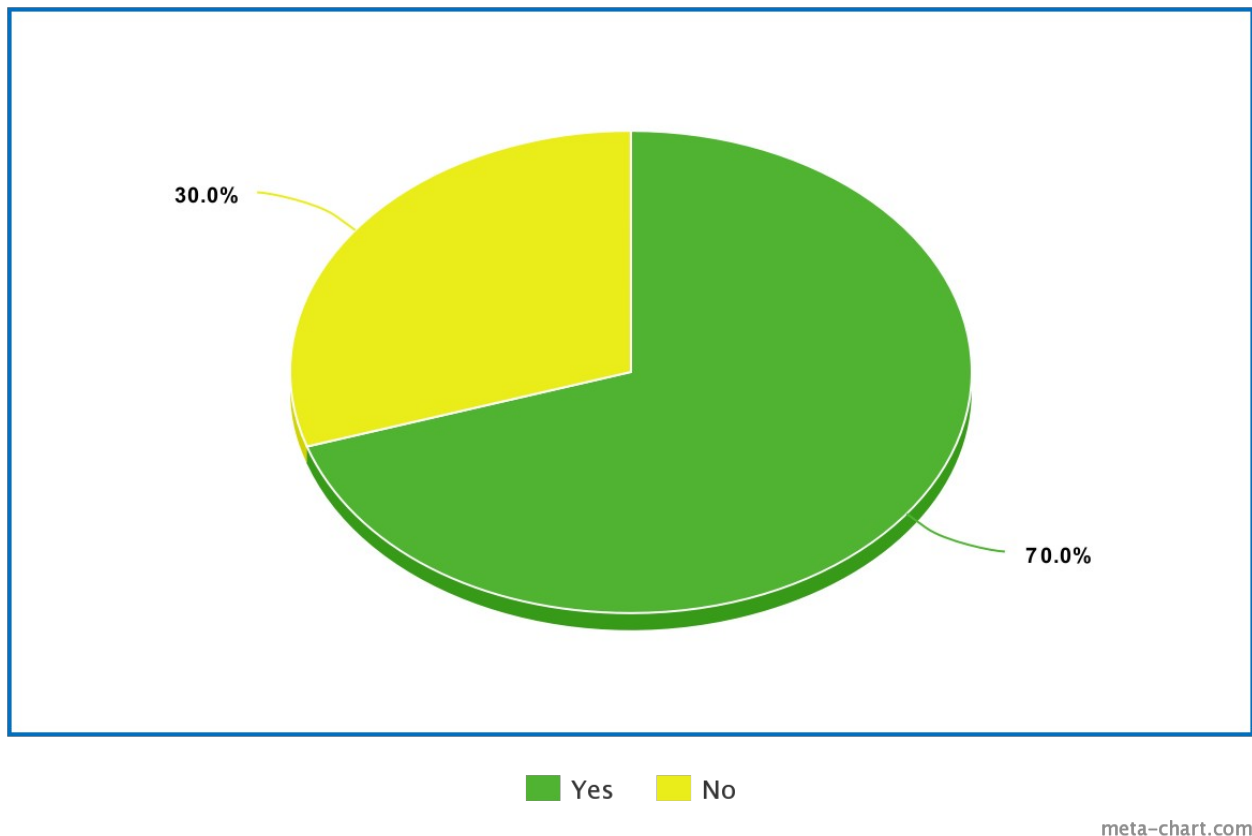

4. Have you been abroad before taking part in the Erasmus+ project?



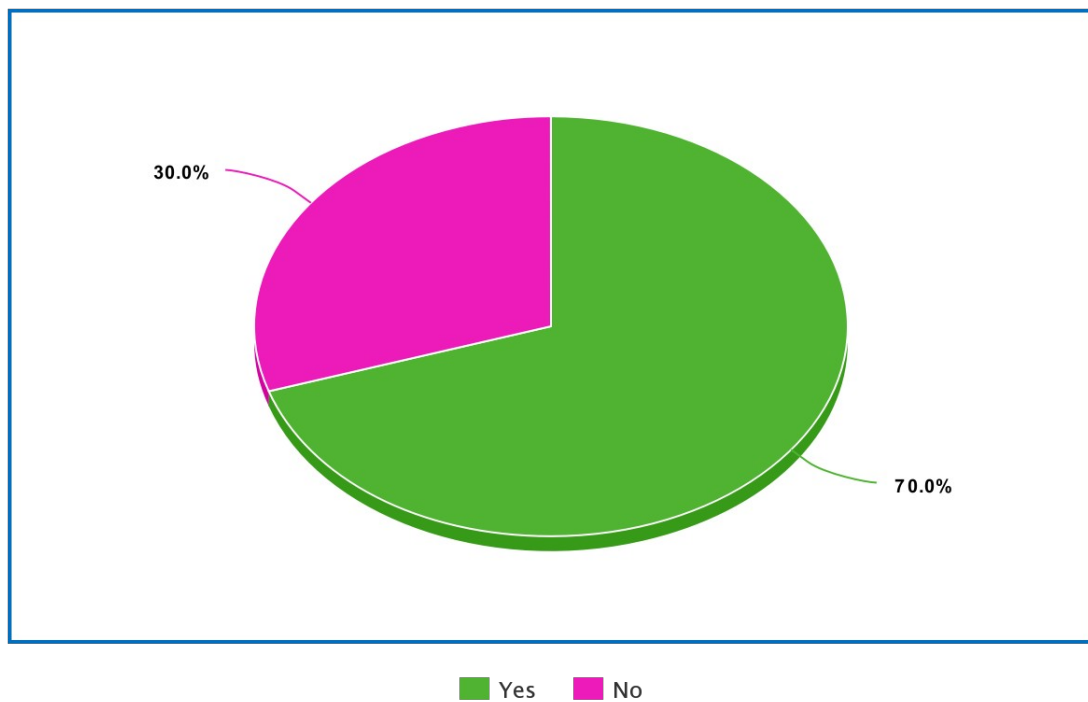

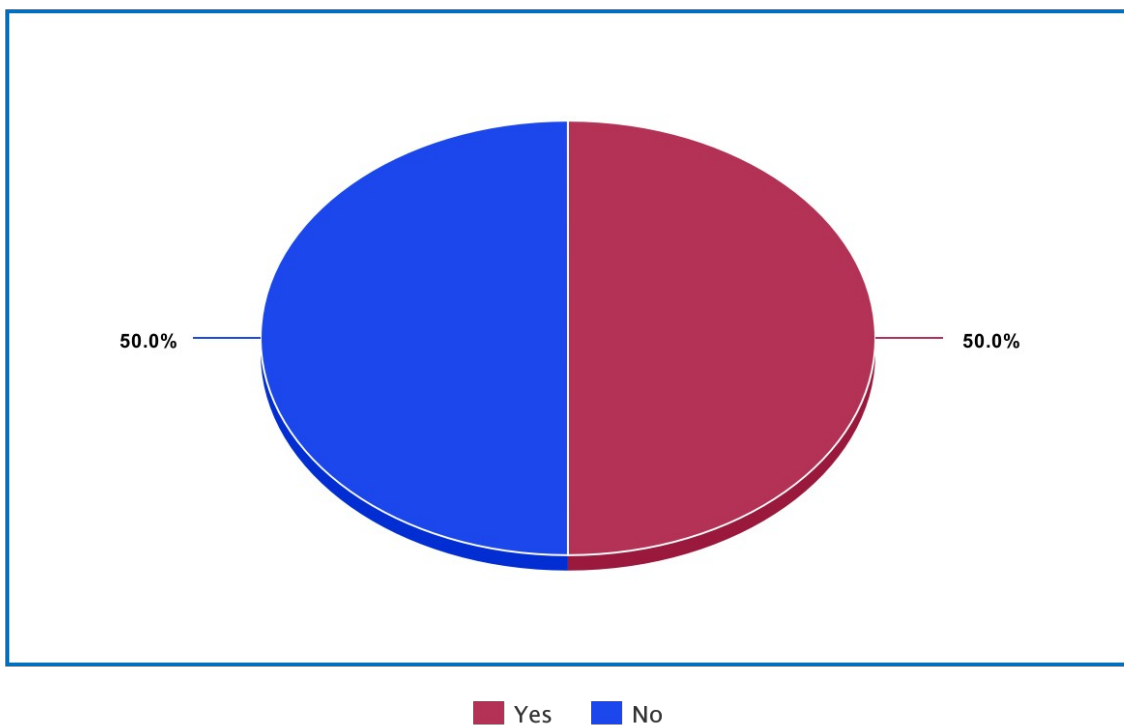

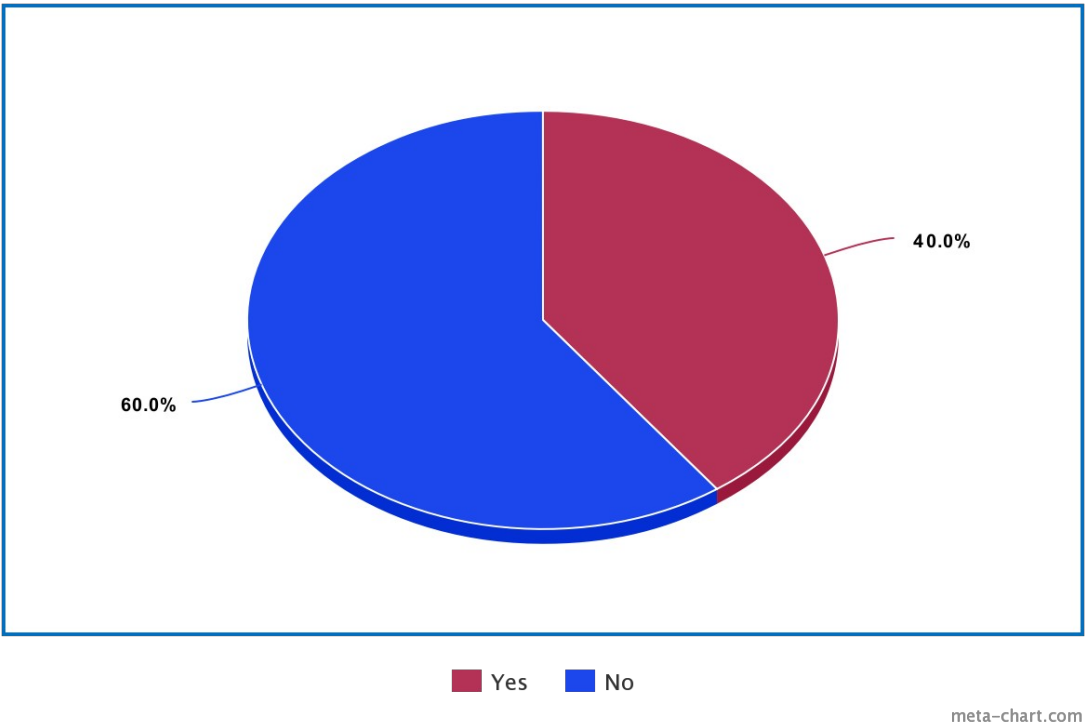

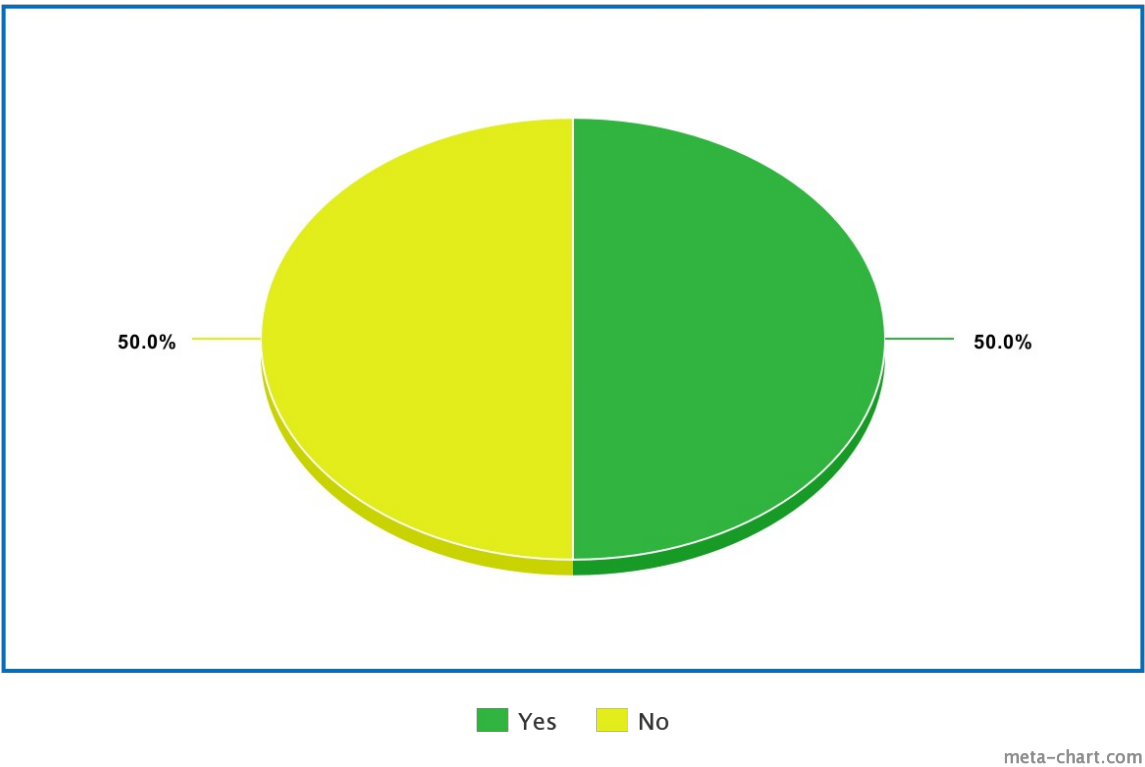
