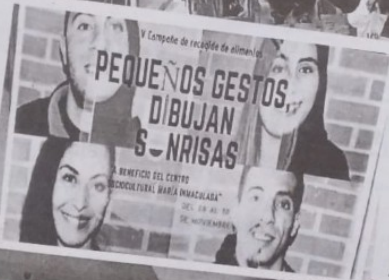
El IES Juan Antonio Fernández colabora en la campaña de recogida de alimentos

GOAL 3: GOOD HEALTH & WELL-BEING


HEALTHY BREAKFAST

GOAL 7: AFFORDABLE AND CLEAN ENERGY

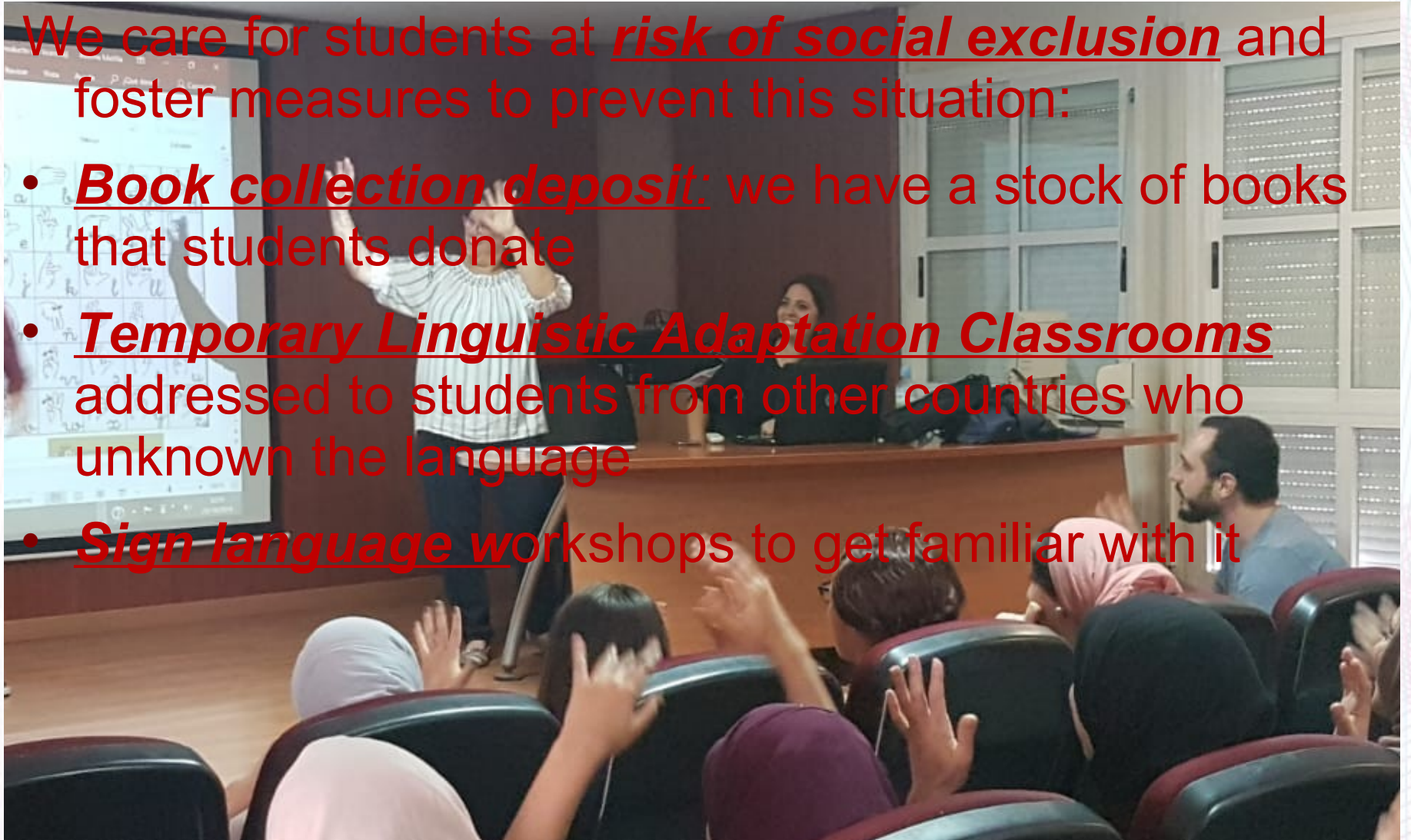
