10	Lead-in	T to Ss
mins	T asks Ss about the degree of Happiness of the	Ss to T

	perspective. T invites Ss to think of the reasons why	
	they have reached the given answers.	
20	Acquisition of new knowledge	T to Ss
mins	While Ss try to find the reasons behind their choices,	Ss to Ss
	Ts invites them to organize in groups of 3-4 and fill	
	in the following 3 columns in a table for each group	
	and focusing on the plays read by each group	
	members:	
	- What do you think drove the characters in	
	their pursuits?	
	- How would you characterise the world the	
	characters lived in?	
	- What do you think made each character	
	happy?	
	The Ss work in groups to fill in the table while the T	
	checks every group's activity.

	- How would you characterise the world we live

	- What do you think makes us happy?
