Topic: Climate change impacts on human health

The **United Nations Environment Programme**,

Keeping in mind the principles of the Paris Climate Change Agreement, which serves as the foundation for climate change concrete actions,

Noting that air pollution caused by industry and transportation has a negative impact on human health and that these branches are the main reasons for climate change and therefor for heatwaves, floods and droughts,

Alarmed by the many big corporations from the developing countries where they can pollute and profit of the country's citizens,

Resolutions:

1. Encourages the establishment of green energy solutions through the development of efficient technologies in creating an electric car industry and a good railway infrastructure:
 - a. By 2030 30% of transportation industry will be green.
 - b. By 2050 50 % of transportation industry will be green.
2. Supports Research & development
 - a. Requests all countries to share all research regarding manufacturing technologies for green transportation in order to improve international cooperation on this topic
 - b. To gather a committee between UN Member States to share all the research made towards combating climate change.
 - c. To introduce instructions for heat event and solid communications structure. Heat plans should include public awareness campaigns, training for medical staff and in the most affected countries, heat protective shelters equipped with the needed supplies
 - d. The use of light colours for streets and buildings as to minimize heat at a street level.
 - e. To force big corporations to search for green alternatives and look for solutions to their pollution problems. At the same time, we provide the funding necessary to enforce this rule in these developing countries by removing their developing budget and providing them with first world country's technologies.
