RULES OF THE LOGO CONTEST FOR THE ERASMUS+ KA229 PARTNERSHIP “NO MAN IS AN ISLAND”

It is the intention of the participating partners to call a contest for the creation of the logo that will shape the identity of the Erasmus+KA229 Partnership according to the following RULES:

1) **TOPIC** - The topic or subject of the design will be free but will make reference, in any case, to the motto of the partnership.

The compulsory data that the logo must have are:

- ✓ **No Man is an Island**
- ✓ **ERASMUS+ STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP**
- ✓ **2018-2021**

2) **PARTICIPANTS** - It is open to all students from the different countries of the strategic partnership who have participated or who are going to participate in the actions of the Erasmus+ association, in this academic year 2018-19 or in the next academic years 2019-21. Each participant will only have the right to present one work.

3) **JURY** - The Erasmus+ responsible for each country will be constituted as a jury of the awards (according to the guidelines established by each center) and its decision will be final. They must choose, between the logos presented by their students, the winner of their country, which will become one of the logos of the association (official in their country).

This jury will be made up of at least two members.

Finally, there will be six logos, one per country, plus the one requested to the graphic designer.

4) **TIMES AND PLACE OF PRESENTATION** - The delivery of the works will take place in each school of the partnership, to the Erasmus+KA229 coordinators before the mobility to Aldaia. The decision of the Jury in each country will be taken before 28/02/2019 and will be kept secret; it will be communicated to the participants on the occasion of the first mobility (Aldaia), on 08/03/2019.

It will then be published on the Dissemination Panels and blog of each participating school.

5) **CONTENT** - Design of the logo and its variations, if it is the case, to reproduce it in:

- Documents of the association (size A-4)
- Information panels,...
- Web and multimedia supports.



6) TECHNIQUE - It will be free taking into account that the logo will have to be reproduced later in different supports and materials. It can be manually or digitally designed using specific software.

7) FORMAT - The originals, which must be unpublished, must be submitted in digital format. If it has been done manually, it must be scanned.

Digital files must be jpg, tiff, png, psd, or similar.

No work may be signed or bear any sign that identifies or allows the identity of the author to be known.

Two closed envelopes will be presented, one inside the other

- Envelope 1 (external) containing:
 - CD or pendrive with the logo created in digital format
 - The design of the handmade logo

If the student wants, he/she can add a small memory of the logo, which should contain all those elements that in the opinion of the creator explain or help to understand the genesis and the meaning of the work.

- Envelope 2 (inside the envelope 1):
 - there will be a piece of paper with the name and surname of the student, the course and the school to which the student belongs.

8) DIPLOMA - After the jury's decision, the winner will be awarded a diploma and certificate in recognition of his or her work, stating that he or she has won the Erasmus+ KA229 "No Man is an Island" logo competition in his or her country, and each participant will also receive a certificate certifying his or her participation. The logo and photos of the award ceremony will be uploaded to TwinSpace.

9) PROPERTY OF THE WORK - The work will remain the property of the Erasmus+ KA229 Partnership "No Man is an Island" and may be reproduced, transferred and used in any way deemed appropriate without payment or consideration to the author.

10) ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES - The participation in this contest implies the total acceptance of the rules as well as of the jury and its decision. The decisions taken by the jury may not be challenged and the jury will be empowered to resolve any situation not foreseen in the rules in the way it deems appropriate.
