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Compulsory subjects at particular educational stages Curriculum Stage 1 (grades 1-3, primary school): early school education, including elements of: the Polish language, social and natural sciences, mathematics, technology, modern foreign language, music and arts, computer science, physical education.

Stage 2 (grades 4-6, primary school): Polish language, history and civics, modern foreign language, mathematics, natural science, music/arts, technology, computer classes, physical education, lessons with class tutor.

Stage 3 (grades 7-8 of primary school): Polish language, history, civic education, two modern foreign languages, mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology, geography, art/music, technology, art classes, IT, education for safety, physical education, lessons with class tutor. 
THE KEY COMPETENCES IN THE CURRICULUM (I)

- 1. Competence in linguistic communication. It refers to the ability to use the language, express ideas and interact with other people in an oral or written manner.
- 2. Mathematical competence and basic competences in science and technology. The first alludes to the abilities to apply mathematical reasoning to solve questions of daily life; Science competition focuses on the skills to use scientific knowledge and methodology to explain the reality that surrounds us; And technological competence, on how to apply this knowledge and methods to respond to human wants and needs.
- 3. **Digital competence**. It involves the safe and critical use of ICTs to obtain, analyze, produce and exchange information.
- 4. **Learn to learn**. It is one of the main competences, since it implies that the student develops his capacity to initiate learning and persist in it, organize his tasks and time, and work individually or collaboratively to achieve a goal.


THE KEY COMPETENCES IN THE CURRICULUM (II)

- 5. **Social and civic competences**. They refer to the capacities to relate to people and participate actively, participatory and democratic in social and civic life.
- 6. Sense of initiative and entrepreneurship. It involves the skills needed to turn ideas into action, such as creativity or risk-taking capabilities, and planning and managing projects.
- 7. **Conscience and cultural expressions**. It refers to the ability to appreciate the importance of expression through music, the visual and performing arts or literature.

Stages of the Education System

Pre-School Education

- Obligatory . kindergarden education is 54-66 months of age.
- Each primary school has preschool classes and also there are schools for only kindergarden students.
- There are also private kindergarden schools

SECONDRY SCHOOL

HIGH SCHOOL

- Non-obligatory
- 4 years
- Types of High Schools

Anatolian High Schools: these scools are to prepare the students for university. In the first two year, all the students study same school subjets (35 hous a week) but after two years the subjects are optional according to students' targets for university.

Vocational High Schools (Meslek Liseleri): Some of these schools may take an additional year to complete. Graduates can automatically go on to higher vocational schools (Meslek Yüksek Okulları - 2 Year Vocational Colleges) in their respective fields of study

Italy - General information

In Italia, il sistema educativo di istruzione e di formazione è organizzato in base ai della sussidiarietà principi dell'autonomia delle istituzioni scolastiche. Lo Stato ha la competenza legislativa esclusiva per quanto riguarda le "norme generali sull'istruzione", e determinazione dei livelli essenziali delle prestazioni che devono essere garantiti su tutto il territorio nazionale e i principi fondamentali che le Regioni devono rispettare nell'esercizio delle loro competenze. Le Regioni hanno la potestà legislativa concorrente in materia istruzione, ed esclusiva in materia istruzione e formazione professionale. Le scuole hanno autonomia didattica, organizzativa e di ricerca, sperimentazione e sviluppo.

In Italy, the education and training system is organized according to the principles of subsidiarity and the autonomy of educational institutions. The State has the exclusive legislative competence as regards "general education", and the definition of essential levels of performance that must be guaranteed throughout the national territory

The Regions have concurrent legislative power in education, and exclusive in the field of vocational education and training

Schools have autonomy in teaching, organization, research, testing and development
