

ASTURIAN MARKETS

Markets with a traditional Asturian setting themed around different historical periods, the Middle Ages, the Romantic Age and the 1920s, the Indians, the Romans, etc... recreate the cultural, artisan and gastronomic essence of the most authentic Asturias.

- El fontán in Oviedo, is the most famous market in the old part of the town. It sells daily fresh products and traditional ones.
- Mercado del Sur in Gijón. It used to be a market in the past, in front of the beach, selling fresh products above all fish, but nowadays it is a building with state offices.
