Main goal of the project: Exchange of good pedagogical practices.

The work on the project will promote understanding and respect for different cultures, history and traditions of the countries.

Our ambition is to prepare children and students to live consciously and responsibly. The project activities are implemented with children aged 3-12, teachers, parents and members of the local community.

The main activities of the project are 5 learning modules in eTwinning and 5 LTT activities. Outcomes of the project include a website, e-books, videos, presentations to be uploaded in YouTube-education and twinspace and thus give feedback to partners and all eTwinning members who are interested in the platform for distributing videos, presentations and crafts.



The use of different approaches and strategies for teaching will motivate the entire staff of the kindergarten and will be an opportunity for each participant to develop the skills of the 21st century and become an active European citizen. The idea is not to compete but to exchange experiences and knowledge, to extract the most useful and interesting and to apply it in our work with children.

From 3.11.2019 until 9.11.2019 our first meeting took place in Athens - Greece with all partners. The meeting was in 21 primary schools "Lela Karagianni". We were greeted very kindly and warmly by colleagues at school. We looked at it, visited the classrooms and taught the lessons. We also observed a pedagogical situation in a preparatory class.

All countries gave presentations. Ours was "This is Bulgaria" with accents Sofia, the presidency, the biggest landmarks in the capital, Veliko Tarnovo and its landmarks, Polski Trambesh renewed today by the long-term leadership of the Mayor - Mr. Georgi Chakarov and our kindergarten "Detski svyat". We presented the teams working with children, the work us and other educational projects, charity concerts, etc.

We also presented our authentic doll "Baba Marta" and Album Baba Marta with photos of martenitsas, a translation of a fairy tale about Baba Marta and a legend about the martenitsa. We also made an e-book for Baba Marta.

We visited the center of Athens, the Municipality of Athens, the Acropolis, the Port of Athens, the Royal Garden, the Marble Stadium - the largest outdoor stadium in the world, the old city of Athens.

We also tried the delicious homemade Greek food prepared by colleagues from the school.

Each country made a box with its own doll, a fairy tale that is told in their kindergarten or school, puzzles and sent to all other countries so that we could learn to tell stories.

From 24.01.2022 to 28.01 2022 was held the third LTT meeting in Kindergarten "Detski Svyat" Polski Trambesh.

We welcomed our partners from Greece, Lithuania, Estonia and Italy (which were included online) according to an old Bulgarian custom with hot pie and colorful salt, served by teachers from the kindergarten.

The meeting was held on the third floor of the kindergarten in our working methodical office. We introduced the guests and hung the badges with everyone's names. I also introduced 11 teachers who work in the kindergarten.

Due to the restrictions on Covid 19 and the avoidance of contact with children, everything was pre-filmed and presented in various presentations.

The official part began with the Anthem of the Republic of Bulgaria. This was followed by a ritual of the children from the preparatory group with 6-year-old children against the background of the Anthem of the kindergarten "Children's



World". After the greeting, we presented to the partners and colleagues our work on the project M.A.G.I.C. until.

The project coordinator, Konstantina Bozonelou, expressed her impression of the report, praised it and suggested that it be published in eTwinning. We had a discussion and the partners expressed their opinion and assessment.

We showed a presentation Kindergarten "Detski Svyat" - National and European values.

For relaxation we presented on the interactive board "Sound and Light" show in Tsarevets fortress.

At 13.00, when the children were already in bed, we showed the partners the kindergarten. They were impressed by the aesthetic design of the study halls and corridors, as each group has its own style according to the teachers who work in it.

The next day partners were again our guests in the kindergarten. We presented the recorded program of the film: dramatizations of three fairy tales "Wheat Bread", "Grandpa and Turnip", "Grandpa's Glove", which were presented by the children of a preparatory group in an interesting interior and costumes.

The participants in the meeting watched a presentation of the pedagogical situation in Fine Arts, given by senior teacher Galya Nikolova on the topic: "Holidays and customs" - showing different visual techniques through modeling, application and drawing. Decorated Easter eggs, martenitsas, a map of Bulgaria made during the pedagogical situation - an application with plasticine and model and drawings on black scratch paper - chalk cardboard for drawing with a wooden pen, we gave to the partners as a souvenir.

The next day we conducted a training with partners and colleagues: We presented "History of the Bulgarian martenitsa and the legend of it." We made a workshop for making martenitsas. We worked in 4 groups, and in each group there was a Bulgarian teacher to help the partners make martenitsa. It was a very emotional workshop. The partners worked with desire and interest and made beautiful martenitsas, which they took to their countries for the children.



We received gifts from colleagues from Greece, Lithuania, Estonia.

The most exciting part was the presentation of a "Bulgaria" plaque for each country. All partners were awarded certificates for participation in the LTT meeting from January 24 until January 28, 2022. For each country we donated one CD with the presented film in our kindergarten. The Bulgarian martenitsa "Pijo and Penda" with the Bulgarian rose oil in the bag - there was one for everyone. One pen, one small ceramic bowl with a lid with Bulgarian yogurt, made by the chefs in the kitchen.

Gift from the Mayor of Polski Trambesh Municipality - Mr. Georgi Chakarov, who presented each partner with a CD with a film about the town of Polski Trambesh "Braid of colorful smiles". His partners thank him from the bottom of their hearts for this gesture of attention.

Since we could not make the meeting with the leadership of the Municipality, due to the mandatory compliance with anti-epidemic measures, I allowed myself to tell the partners about our Mayor Mr. Georgi Chakarov, who completely renewed and revived our city. I took a short walk of the partners in the center of the town - the park with the monument, the fountain, which is unique, the hospital, the hotel, the municipality, the double lane, divided by green lawn, trees and more.

We visited Veliko Tarnovo - "Park of Miniatures", Tsarevets fortress - the symbol of Veliko Tarnovo, Dryanovo Monastery and the cave "Bacho Kiro". They enjoyed the beauty of Bulgarian nature in winter. A wonderful week filled with a lot of emotions and mood.

We sent our partners very impressed and satisfied with the mobile meeting.
