### Lesson Plan I

**Length of time**: 60 minutes

#### **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. Introductory activities:
  - greeting the students
  - identifying language and artistic lexicon;
- 2. Opening to lesson
  - announcement of the topic of the lesson
- 3. Development of the lesson

The teacher illustrates:

- specific lexicon
- graphic expression techniques for the representation of geometric figures and simple volumes
- fundamental elements for reading a work of art (painting, architecture, sculpture)
- students make compositional-formal observations on works of arts
