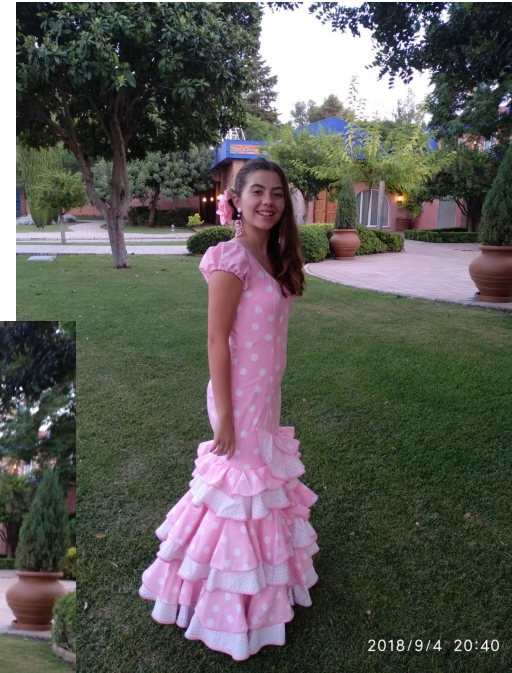

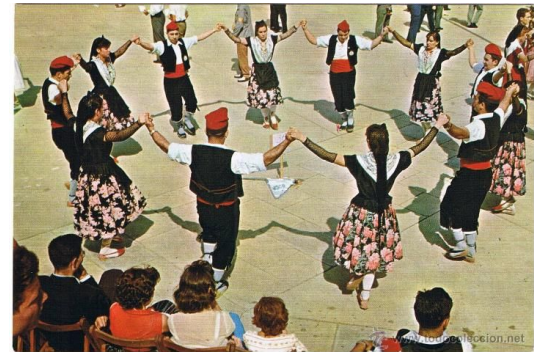
# DANCE IN SPAIN

# CARAMELLES

Performers or 'caramellaires' are groups of children or adults who go out to sing outside houses and farmhouses on Easter Saturday at sunset or on Sunday and Monday morning.
