Lesson Plan

LENGTH OF TIME: 60 min.

TOPIC: Puppet animation.

OBJECTIVES:

The student is able to:

- -perform basic movements of the puppet: "the doll looks", "the doll goes", "the doll gets up", "the doll sits",
- play a few simple movement sequences with the partner, based on the "action reaction" principle,
- put the word under the doll's movement one or two sentences.

TEACHING METHODS AND STRATEGIES:

- practical exercises,
- animation,
- show

RULES FOR TEACHING

- triggering creativity, initiatives
- building the sense of achievement in student

ASSIGMENTS:

- individual work
- work in pairs

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- puppets

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Warm-up with music we warm up all body parts briefly.
- 2. The teacher shows several different dolls puppets and explains how the doll moves imitates human movements, but in an exaggerated way.
- 3. Practical exercises each participant gets a puppet and uses it to animate it, imitating the teacher's movements: "the doll is watching", "the doll is walking", "the doll is getting up", "the doll sits".
- 4. The teacher shows how the puppet moves while speaking.
- 5. The teacher divides the team into pairs. Each pair has the task of preparing a dialogue between the puppets on the principle of "action" "reaction". The puppet speaks and moves, while the second listens, then the first stops, the second answers. The dialogue is to be integrated into a specific situation so that the doll can stand up, look, walk.
- 6. Work in pairs.
- 7. Presentation of work results.
- 8. Summary conclusions, corrections, statements of participants about the exercise
