


GAME REVIEW

<p>TITLE</p>	<p>Monopoly</p>
<p>BRIEF GAME DESCRIPTION / GAME TYPE/GOAL</p>	<p>Monopoly is a board game and hasn't got a goal. The game finishes when you want and the winner is the person who gets more money.</p>
<p>PLAYERS (number, age)</p>	<p>Minimum of players are two, and maximum six. The game recommends not playing before eight years old.</p>

<p>RULES (explain the different steps)</p>	<p>When it is your turn you throw two dices and you land on a section. If you buy the section when the other players land on your section they have to pay. If you want, you can buy houses or hotels too and when the other players land on your properties they have to pay you more money.</p>
<p>WHEN DOES A GAME END?</p>	<p>When you want.</p>
<p>ASSESSMENT (What did you like? / What didn't you like? Why?)</p>	<p>The competitiveness when I win because I can tease the other players/ I don't like it when the other players are better than me and they win because I get aggressive. (We both agree on the answer)</p>
