





- * Easy and Fast Process Application process will take 1-3 months.



Some common European rules

- Refugees have one chance to apply for asylum
- Shelter = responsibility of country of arrival
- Common rules about return

Crisis measures

- 1. A temporary distribution plan
- 2. Revising **Dublin**? \rightarrow a permanent distribution plan
- 3. A better fight against **smugglers**

Crisis measures

- 4. More border control by **Frontex**
- 5. Rescue operations **Titron** (Italy) and **Poseidon** (Greece) picking up refugees
- 6. Speeding up the **return** of refugees

Crisis measures

- 7. Deal with Turkey
- 8. Deal with 16 countries in Africa and the Middle East
- 9. Support countries of origin
