BIOGRAPHY

Anne Frank was a German girl and Jewish victim of the holocaust. She is famous for keeping a diary of her experiences. Anne and her family went into hiding for two years to avoid Nazi persecution. Her documentation of this time is now published in The Diary of a Young Girl.



- Her parents, Otto and Edith Frank, moved to the Netherlands from Germany after Adolf Hitler and the Nazis came to power there in 1933 and made life increasingly difficult for Jews.
- In 1942, Frank and her family went into hiding in a secret apartment. The Franks were discovered in 1944 and sent to concentration camps; only Anne's father survived.







DIARY OF ANNE FRANK

- The diary provides a vivid and poignant glimpse into the world of a young Jewish girl living in Nazi occupied Holland.
- Anne had hoped to become an author, and during her time in hiding she wrote several short stories. as well as her diary.
- He knew Anne had always wanted to be a writer and he consulted various people about his dilemma. He finally decided to find a publisher for the diary
